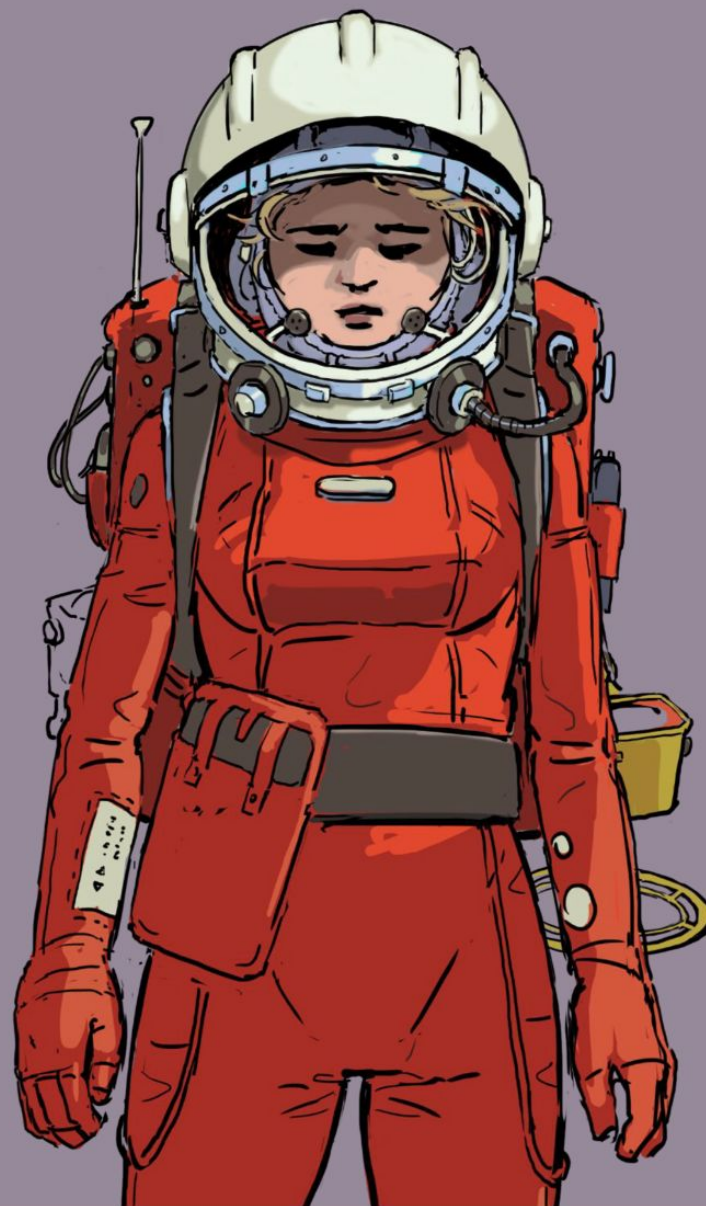










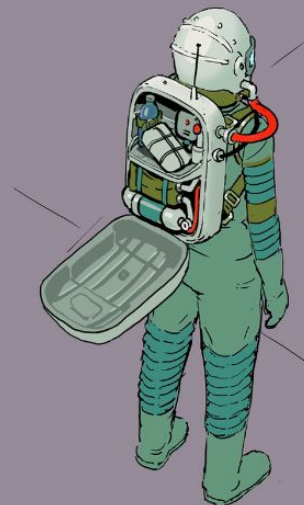
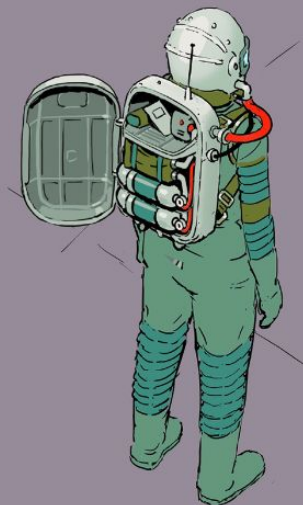
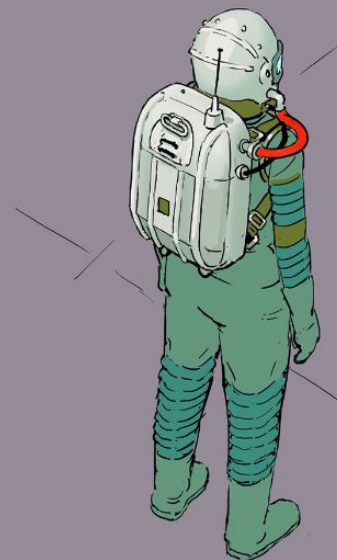


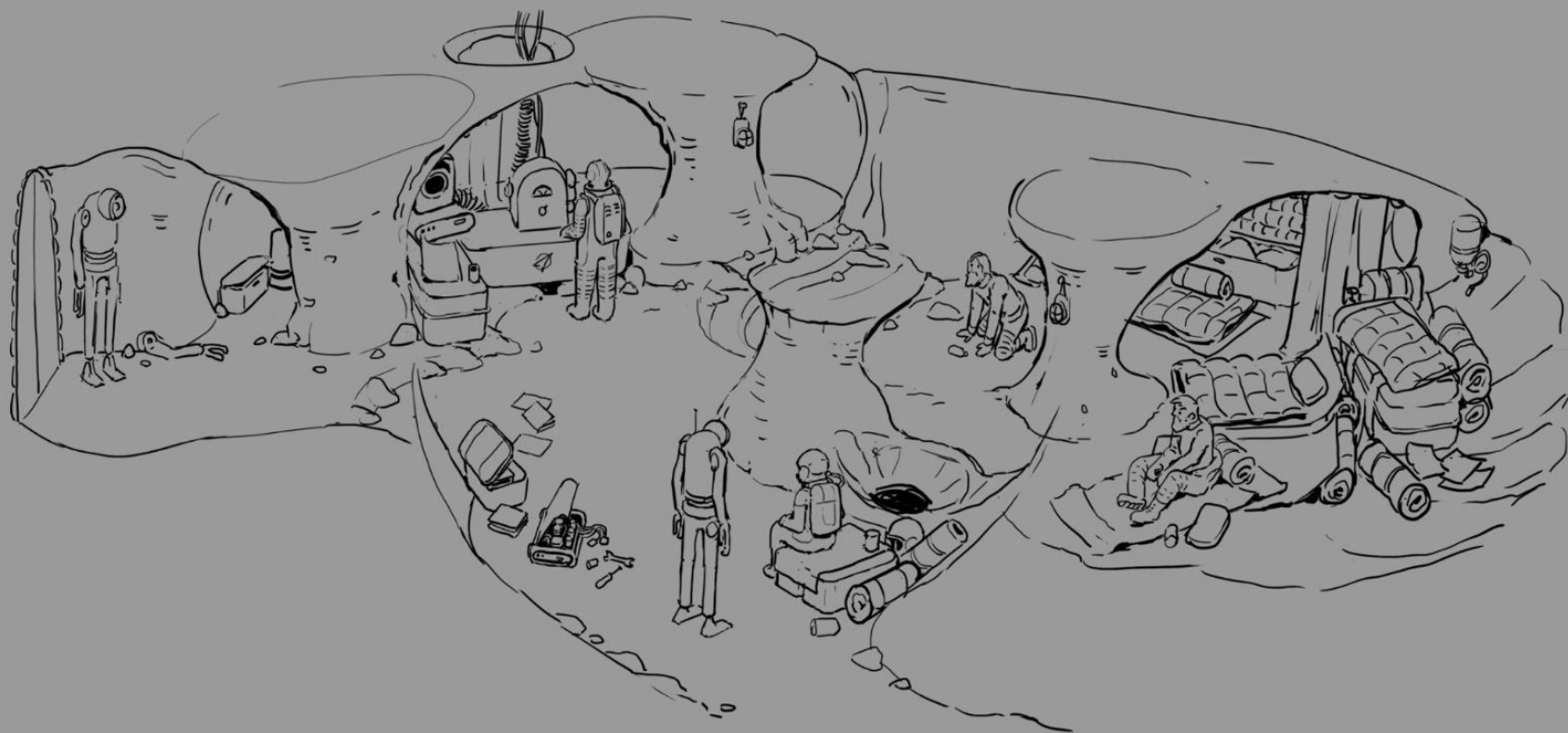


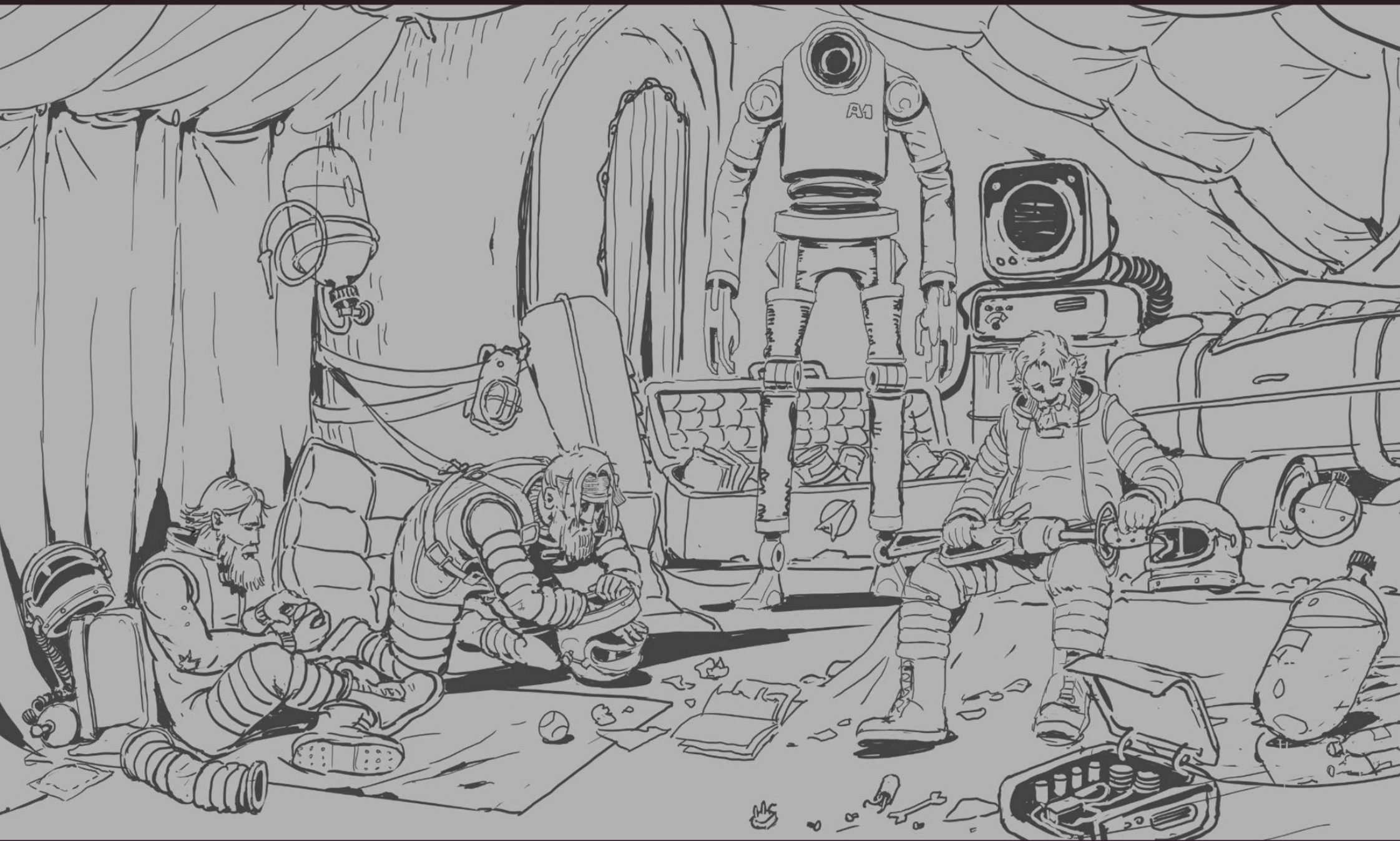
SURVIVORS

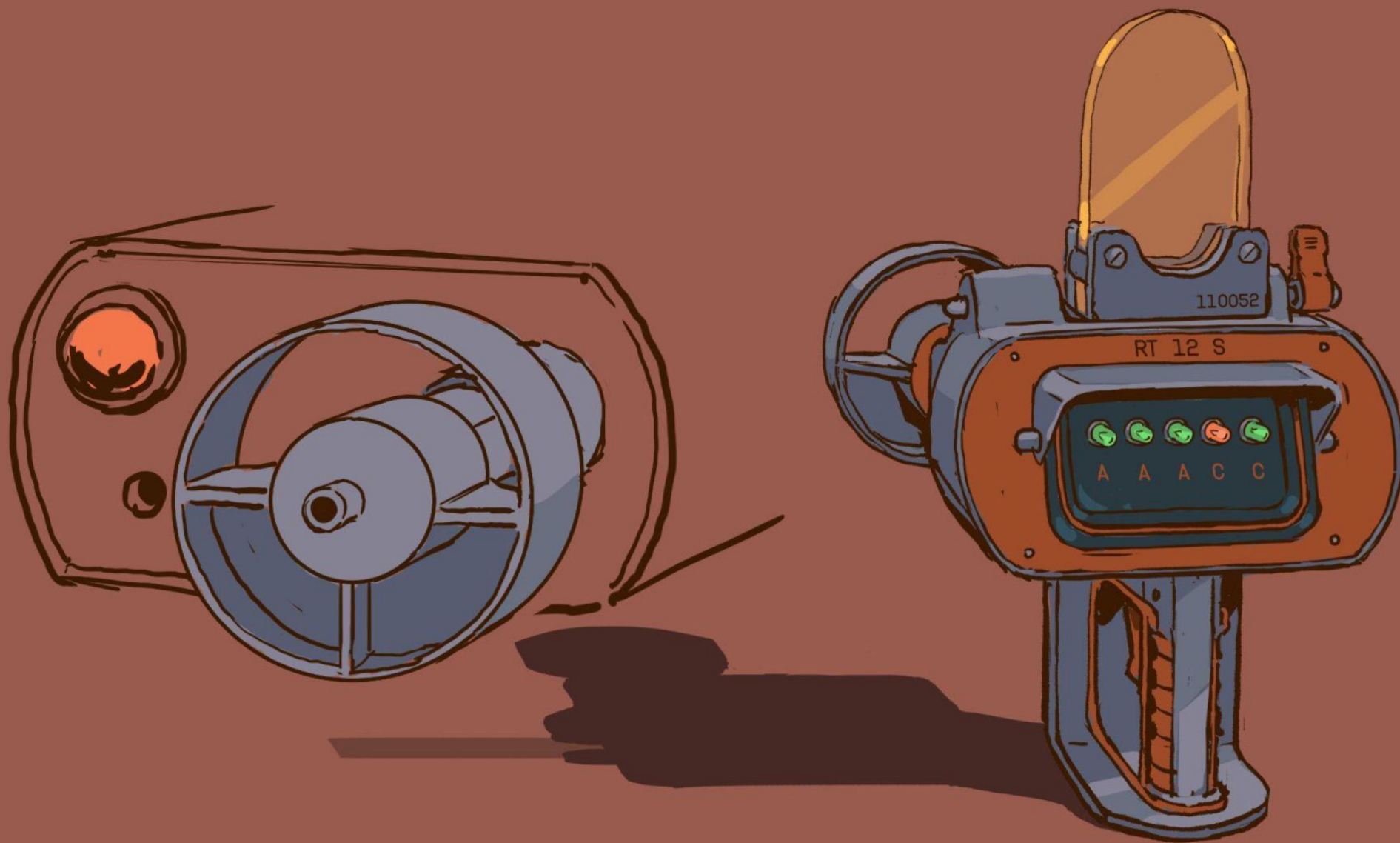


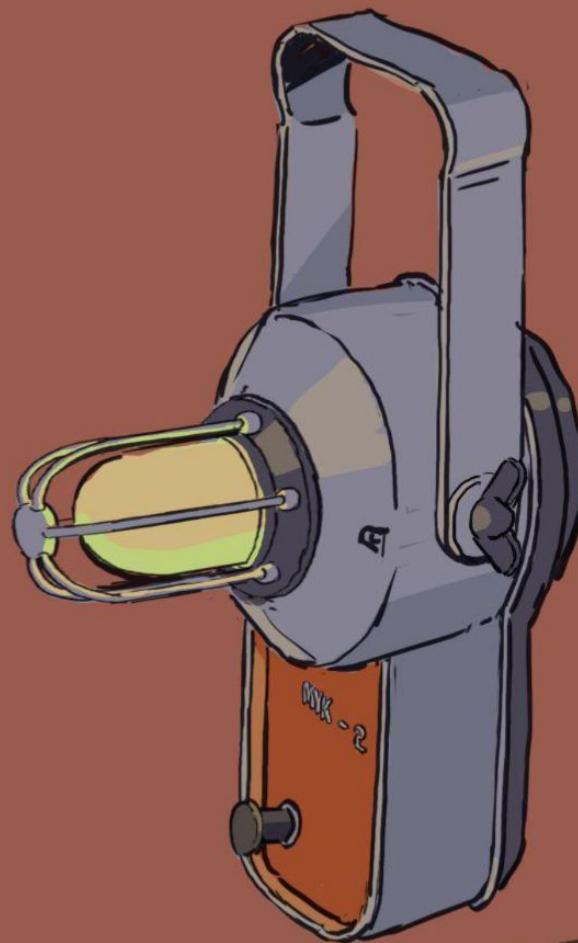
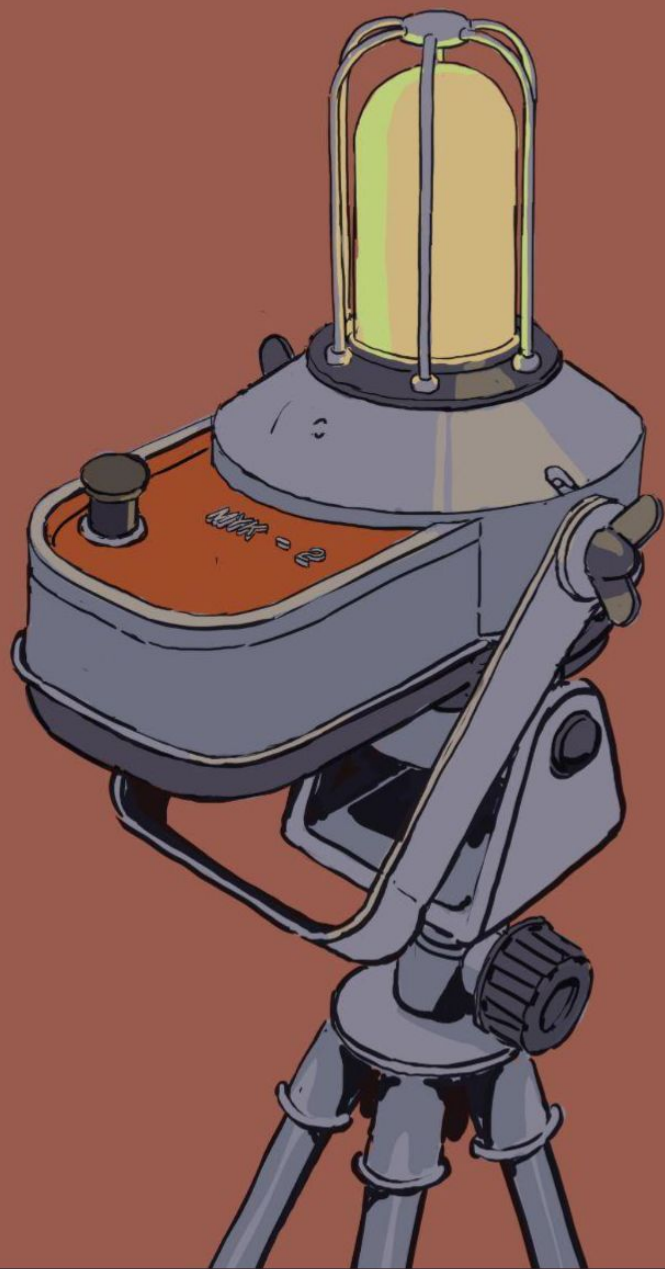


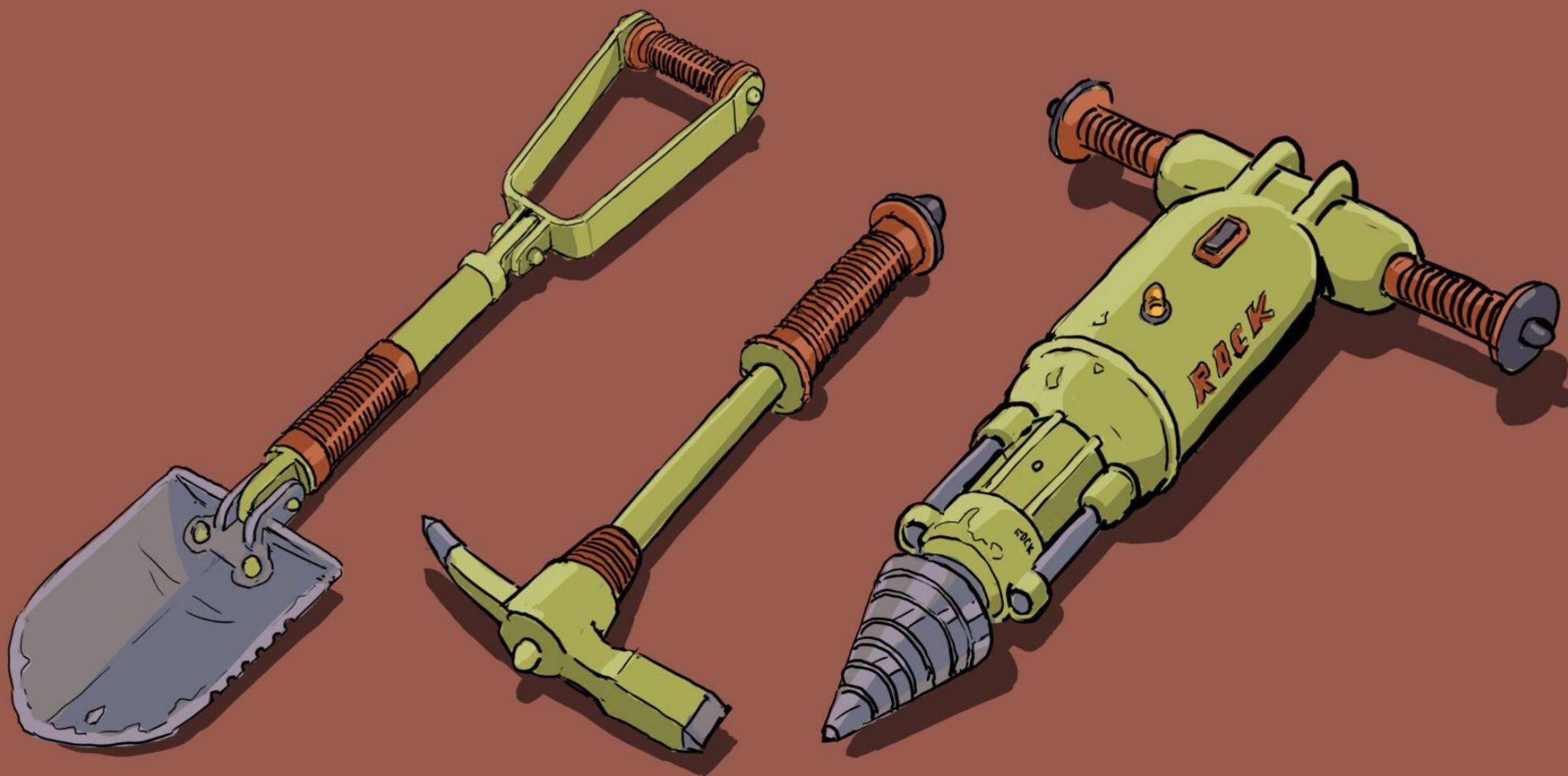


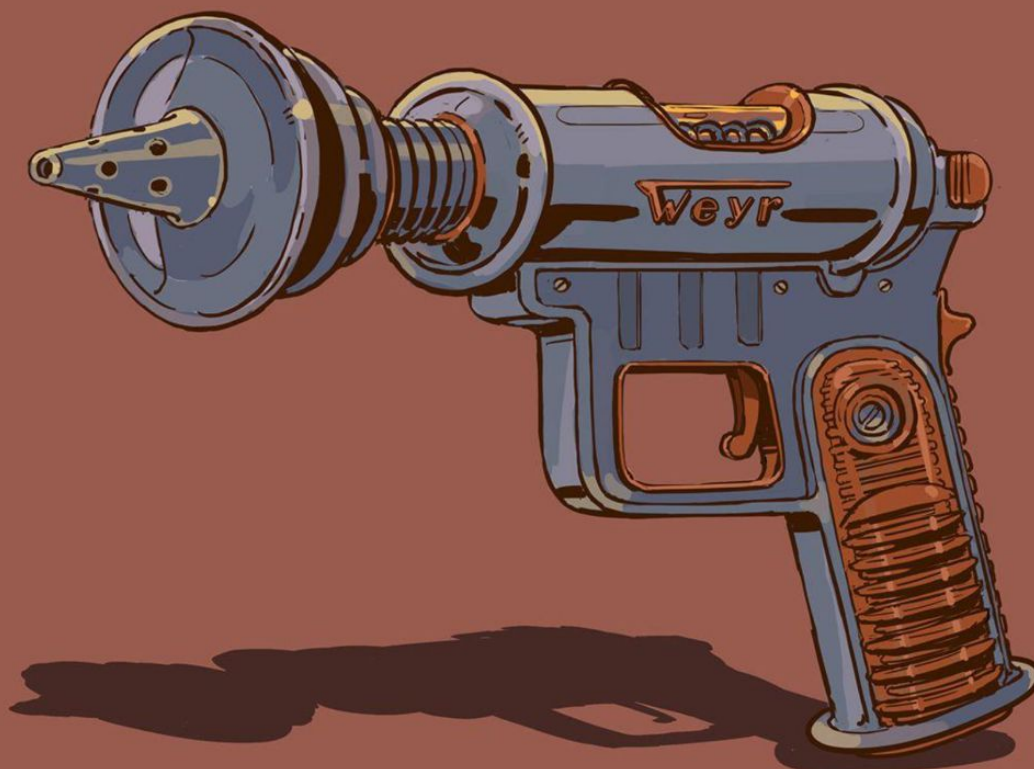
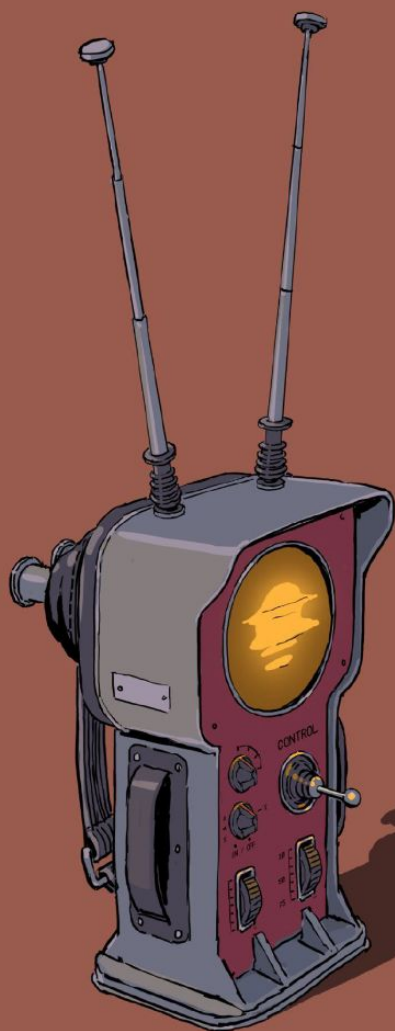




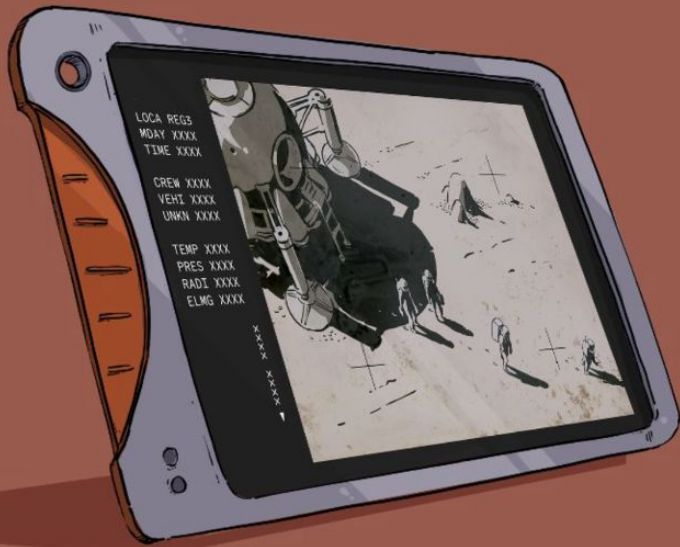


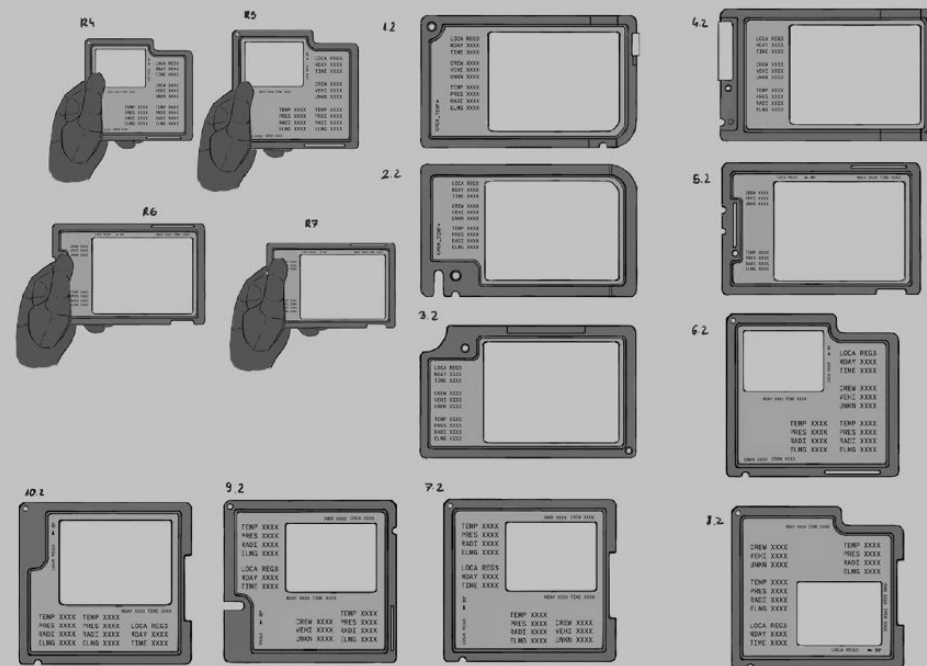
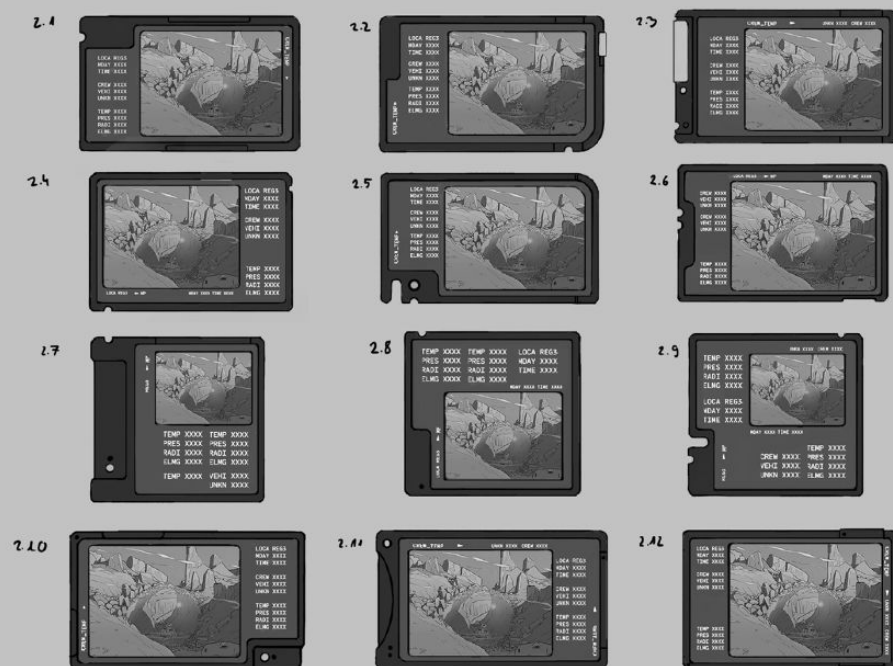
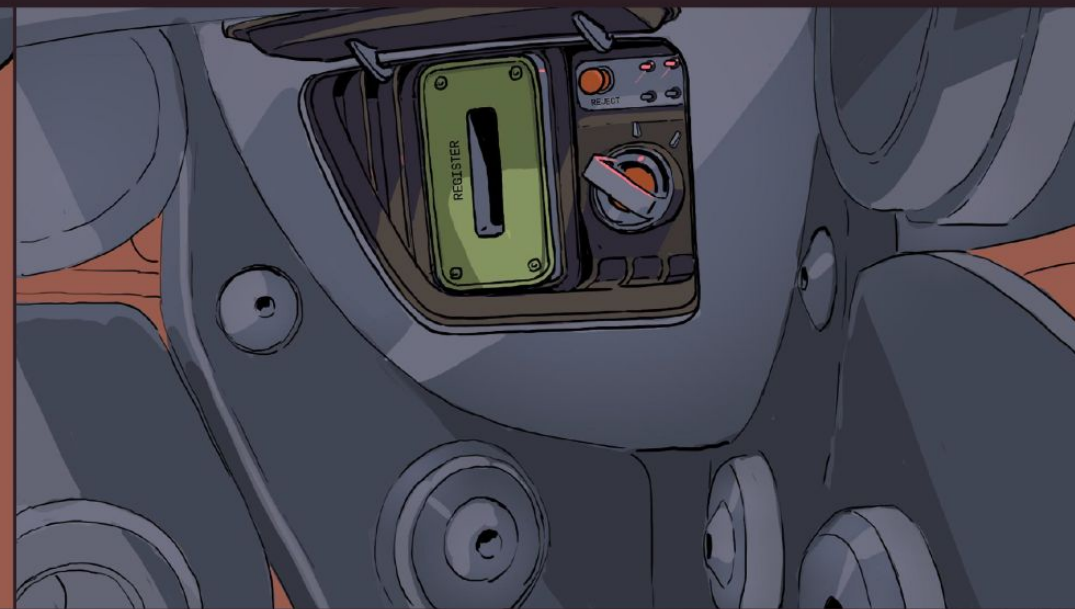


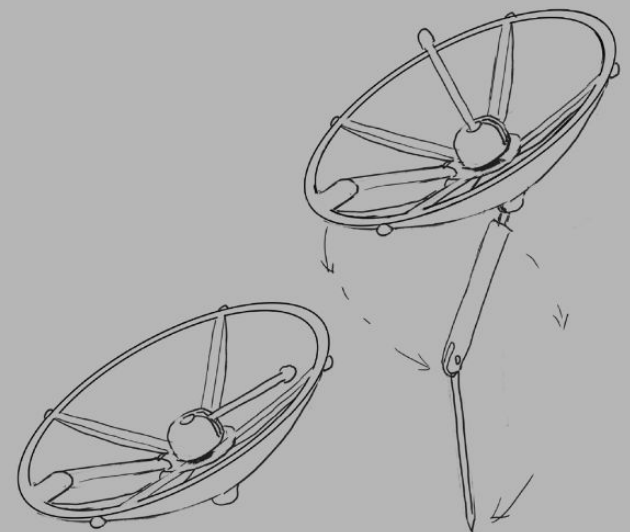
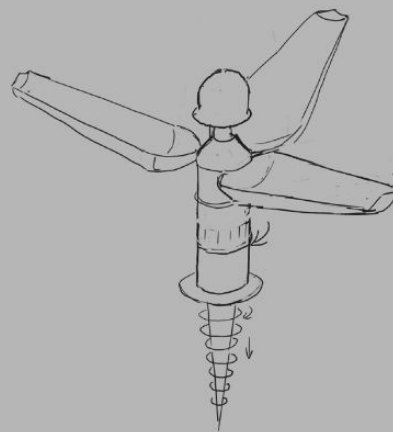
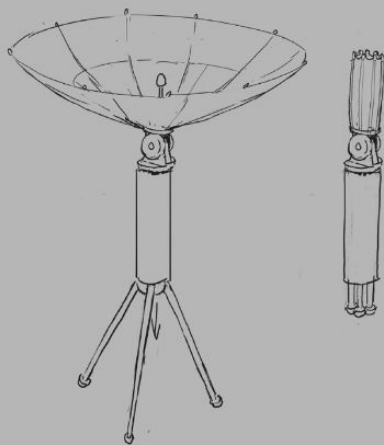
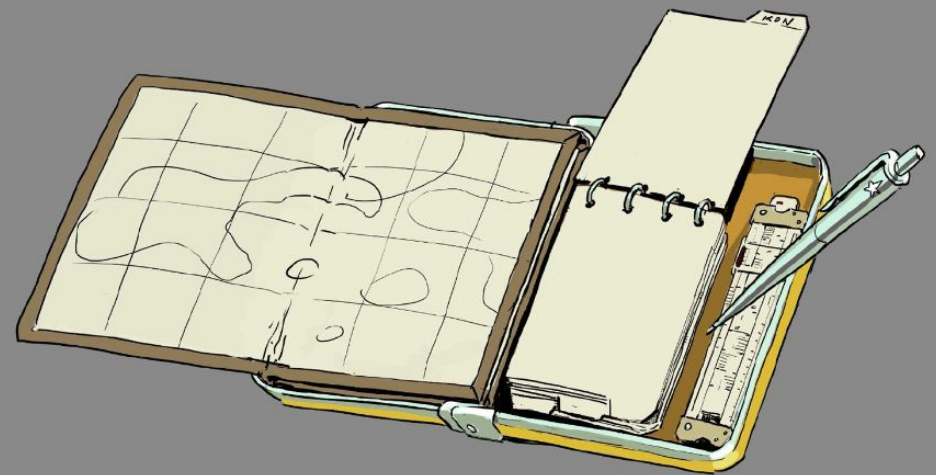
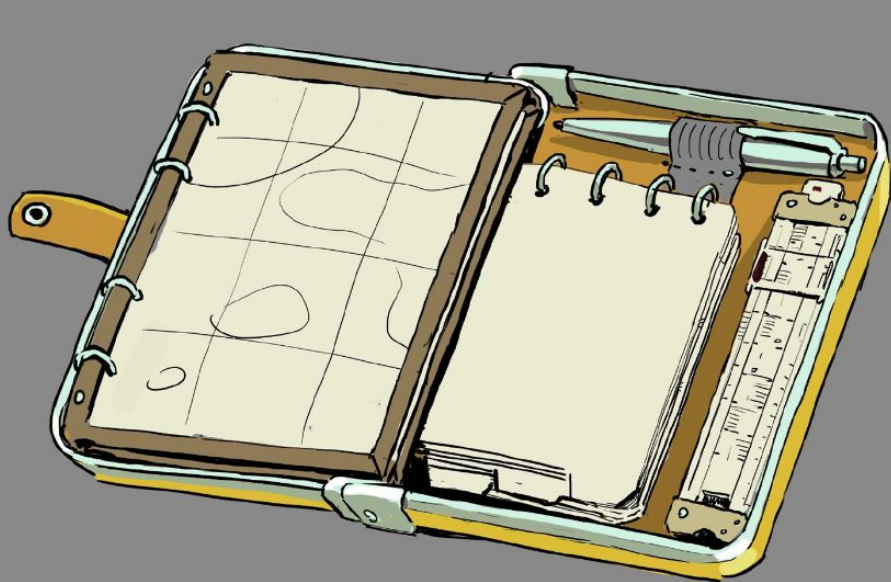


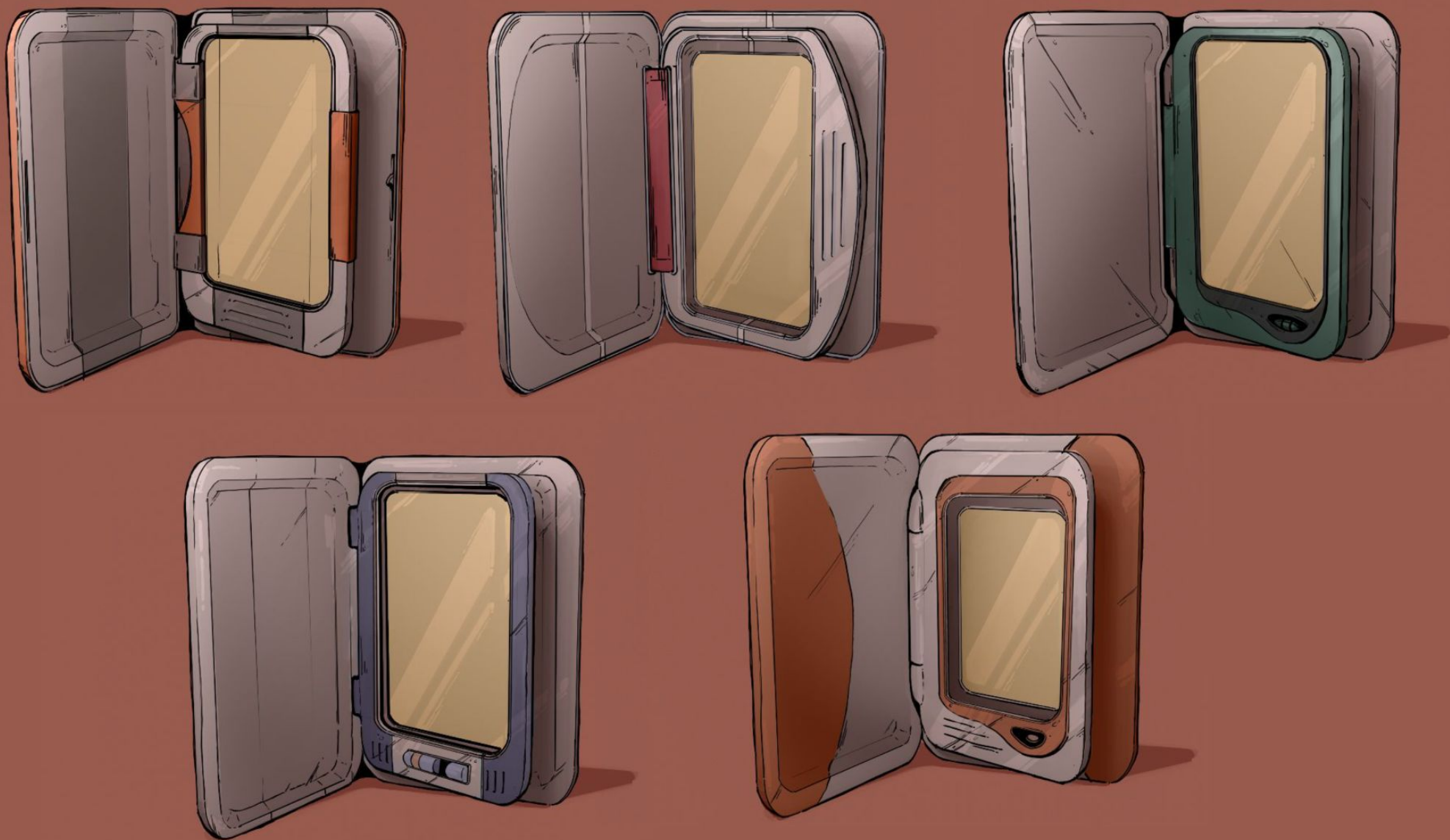


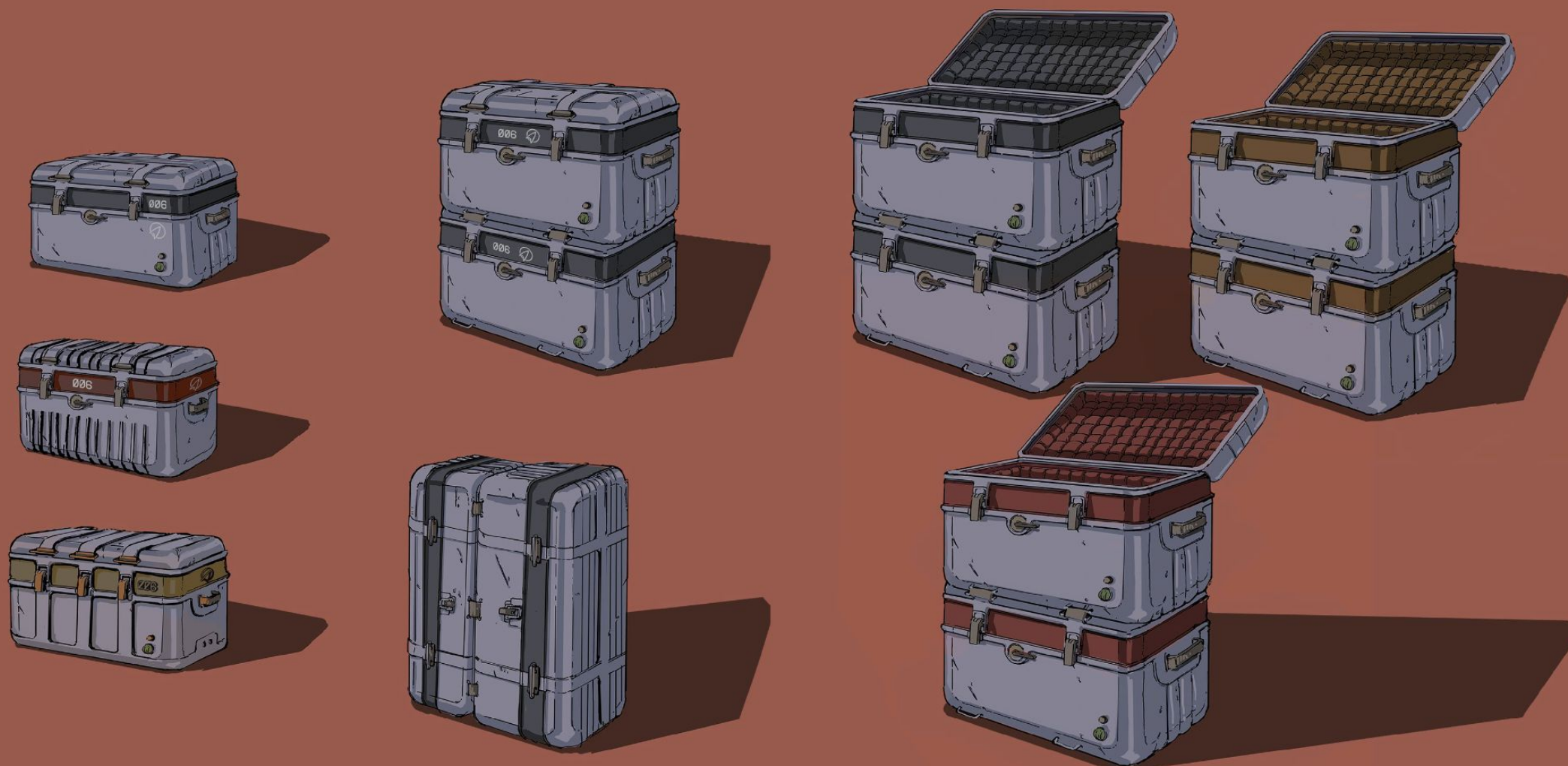


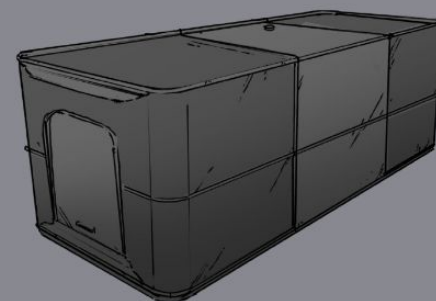
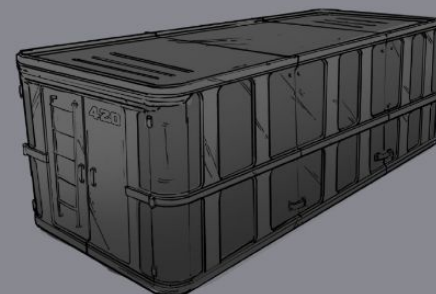
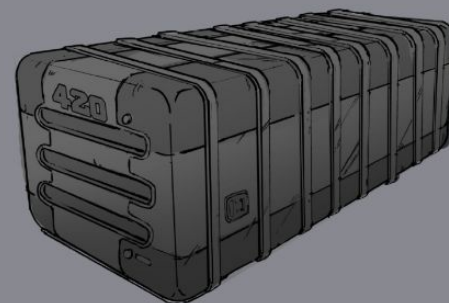


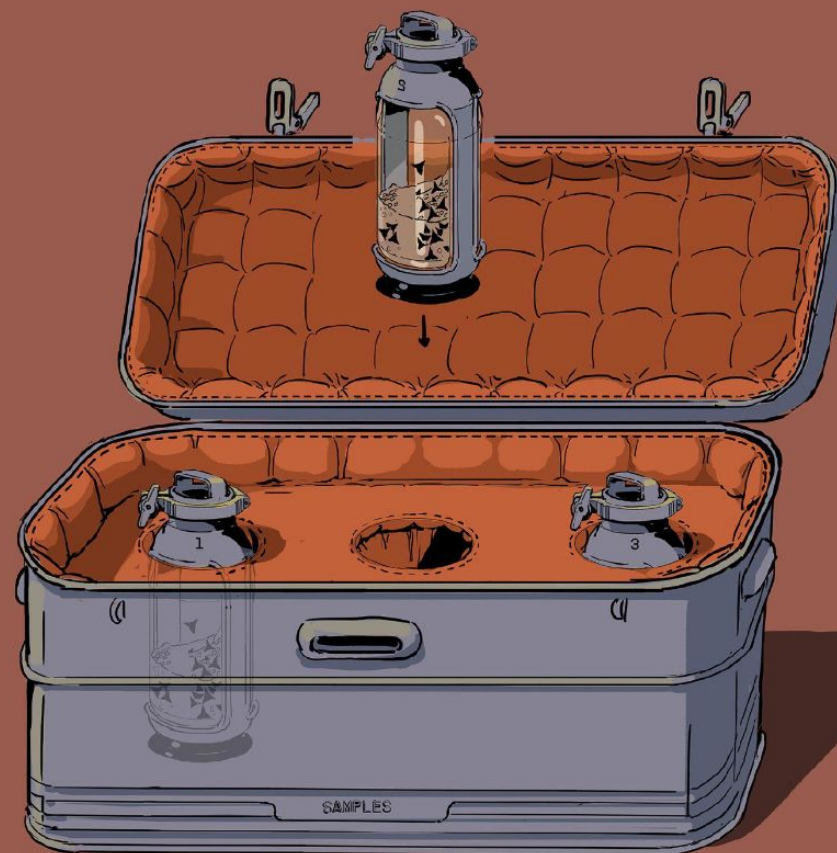
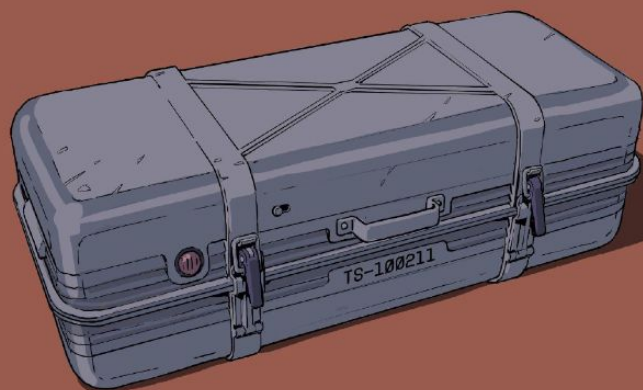




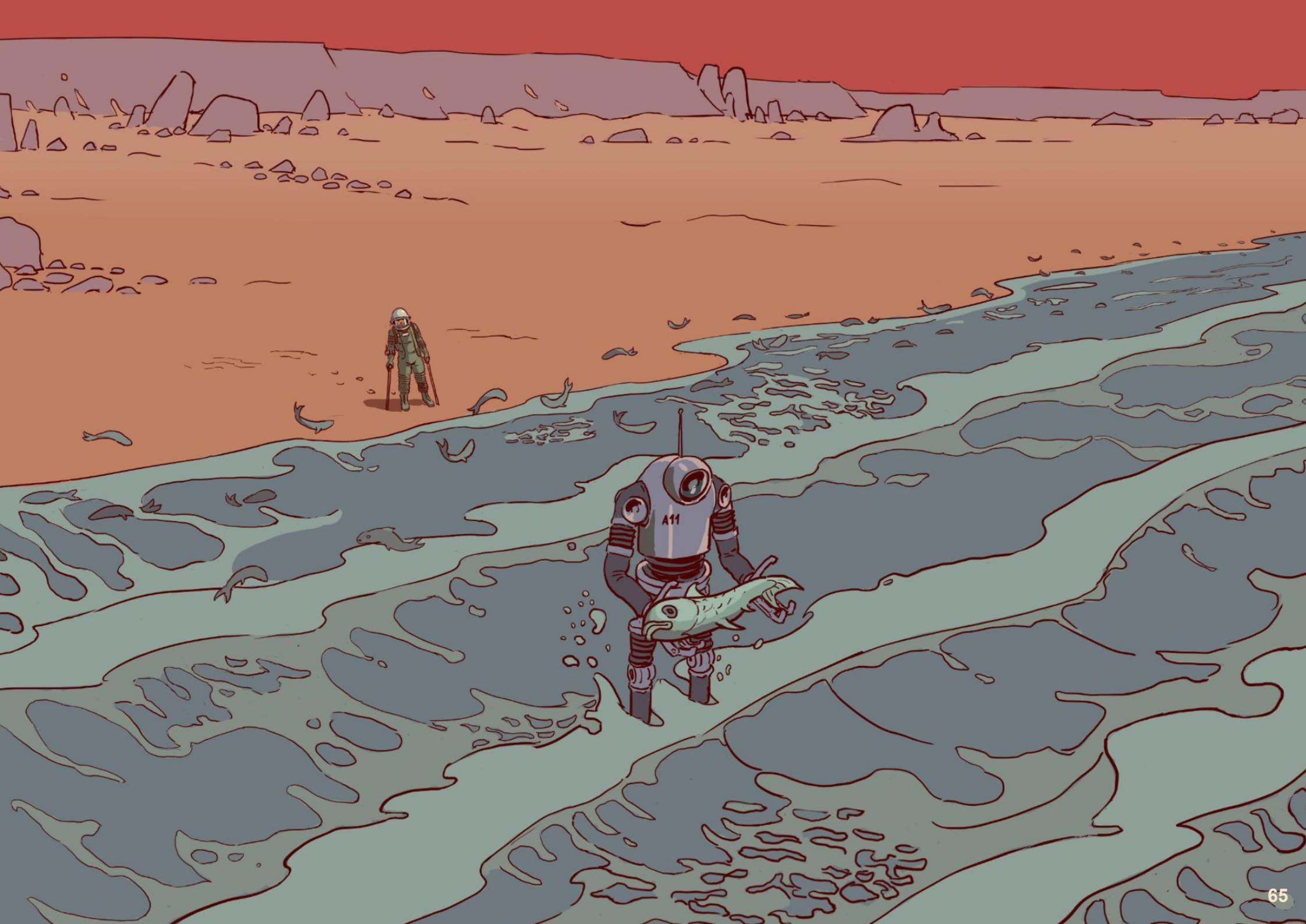








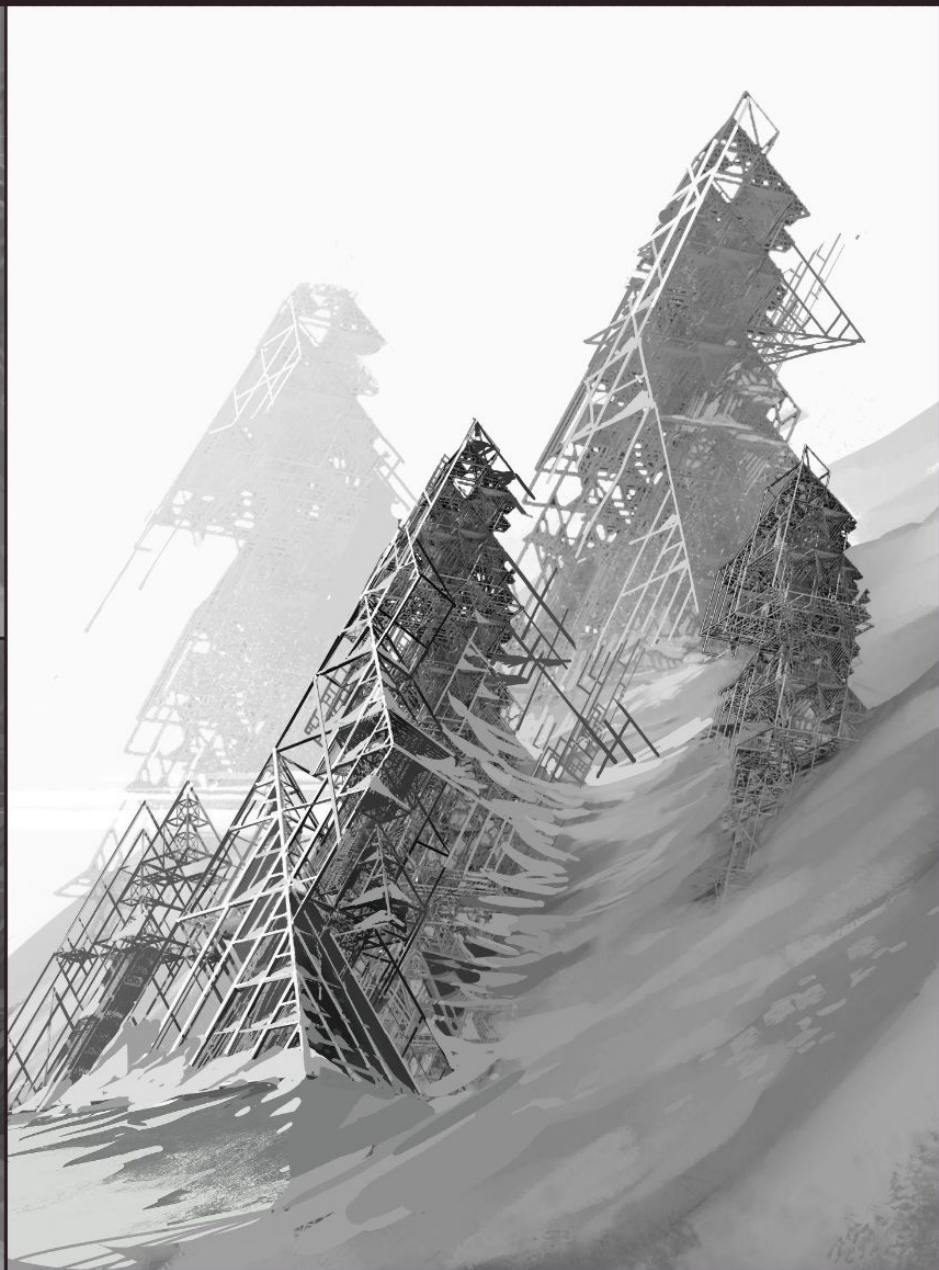
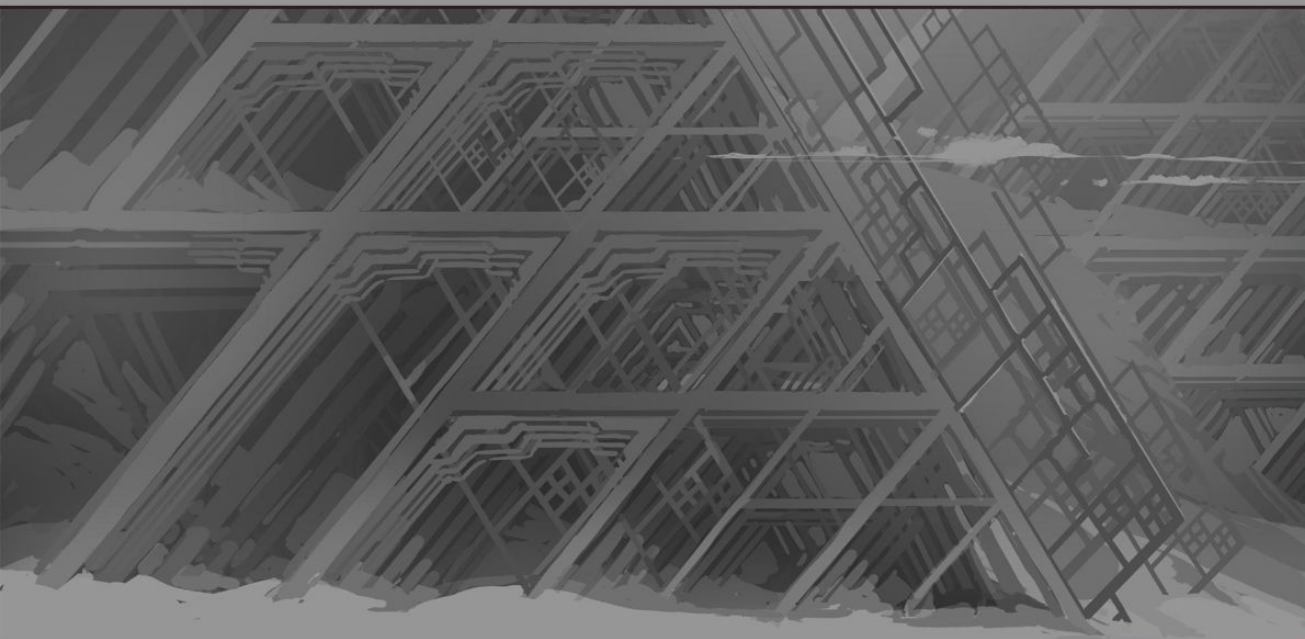
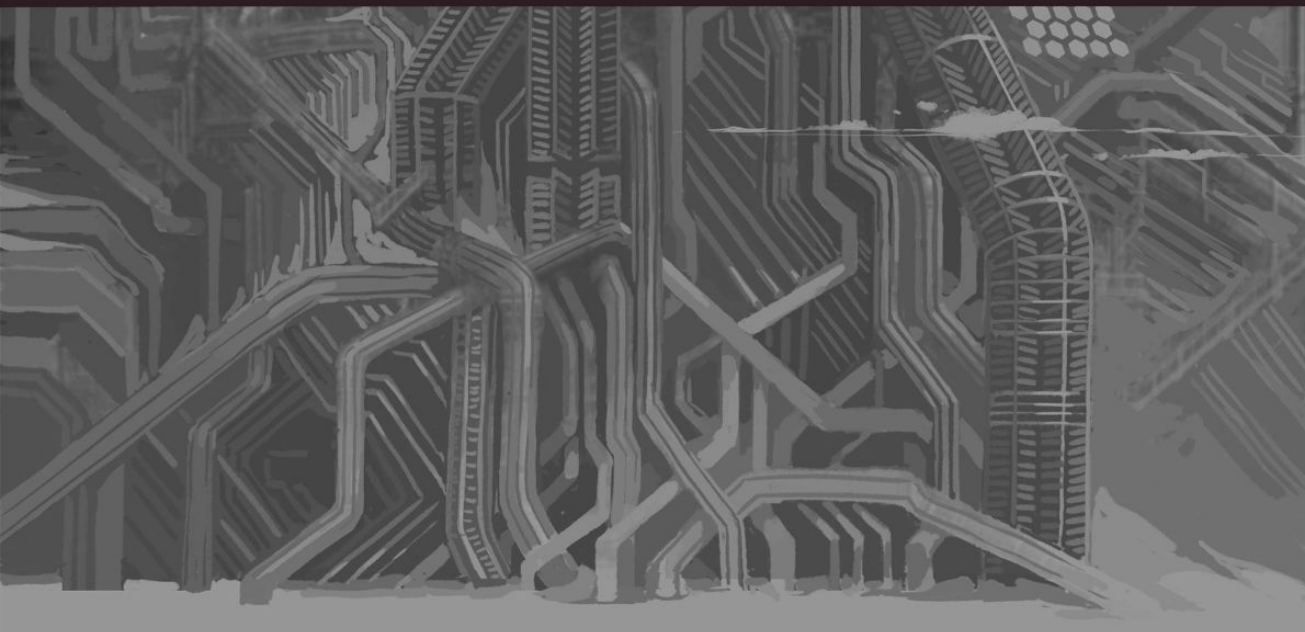


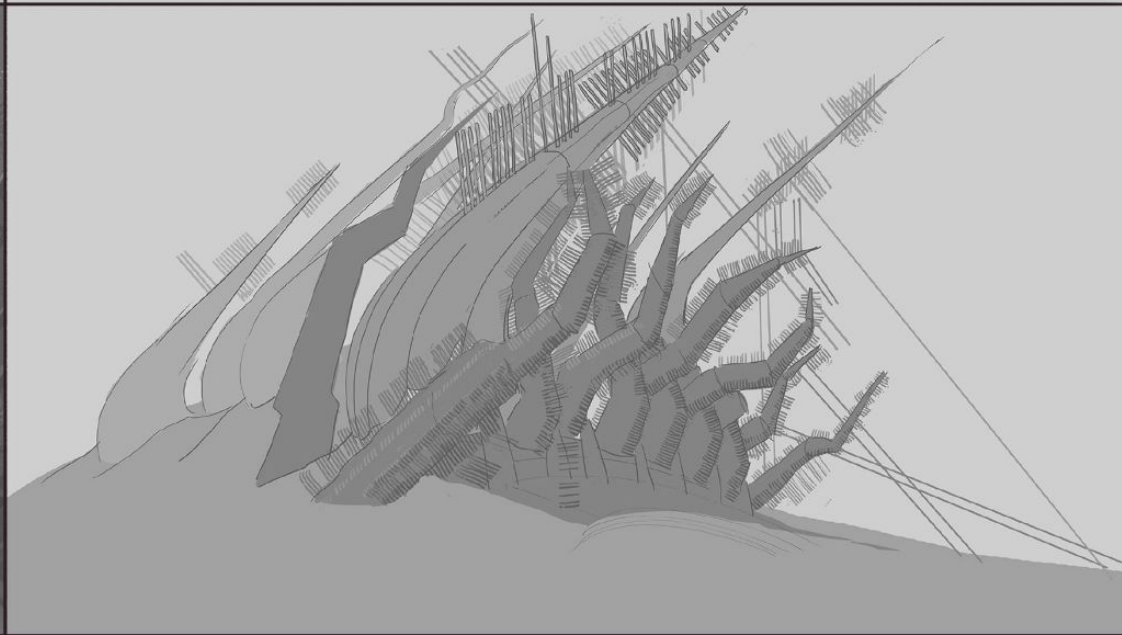
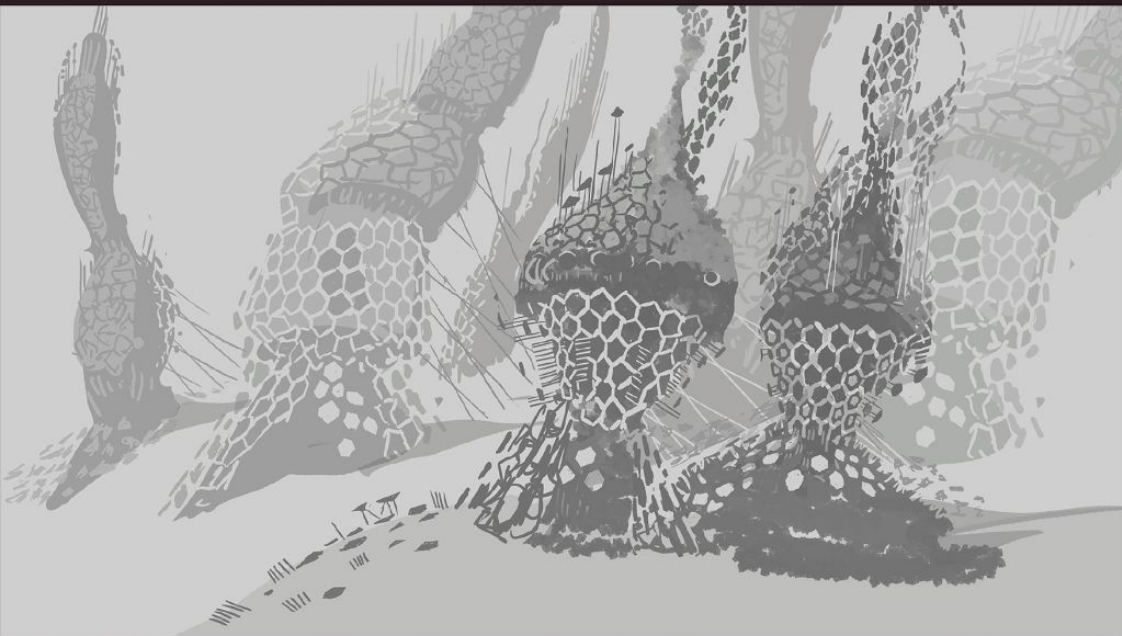


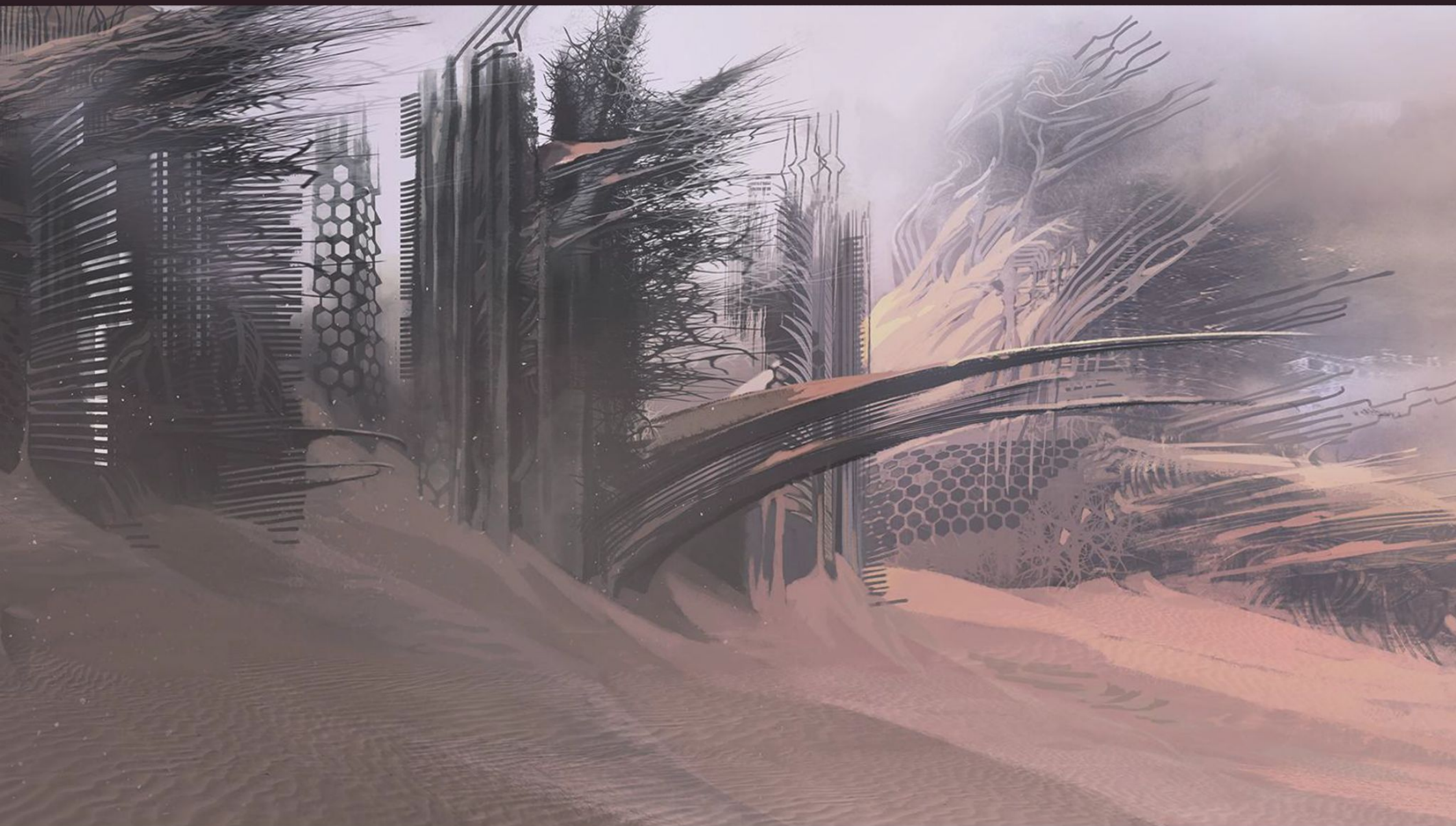
NECROEVOLUTION

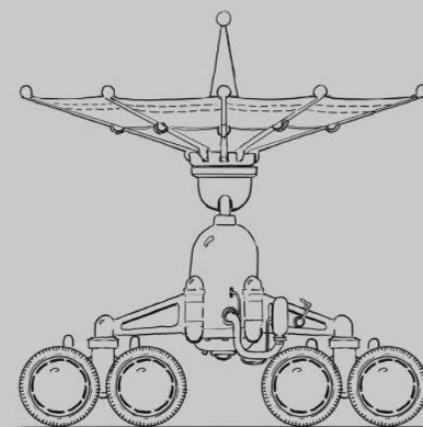
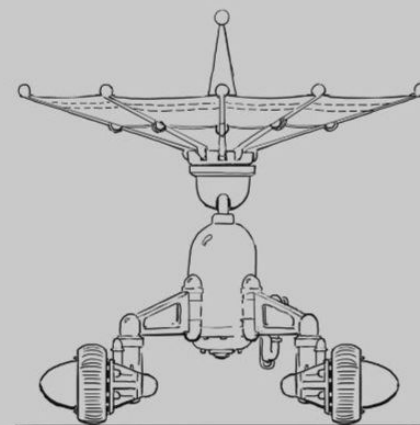
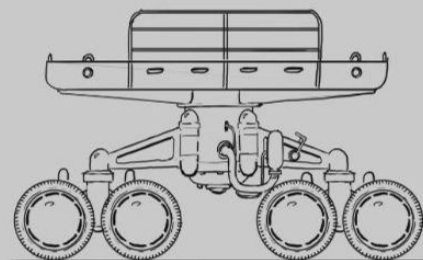
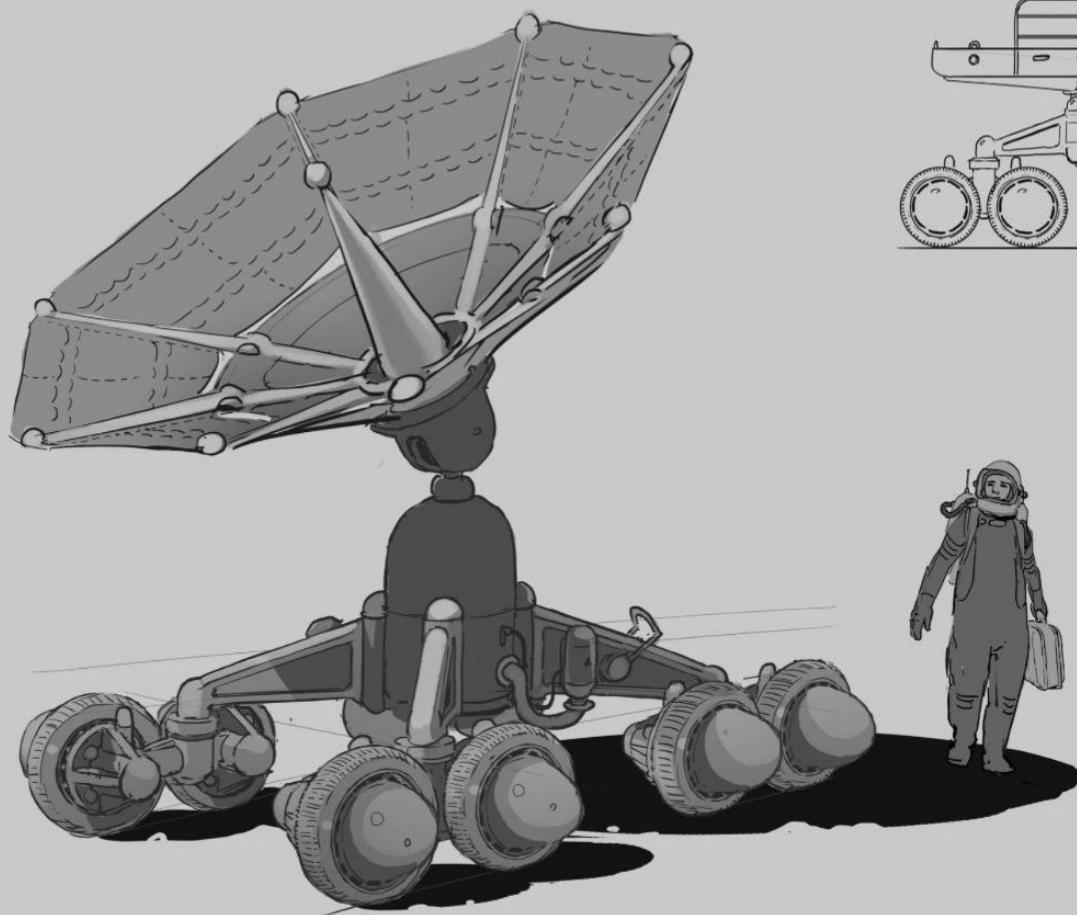


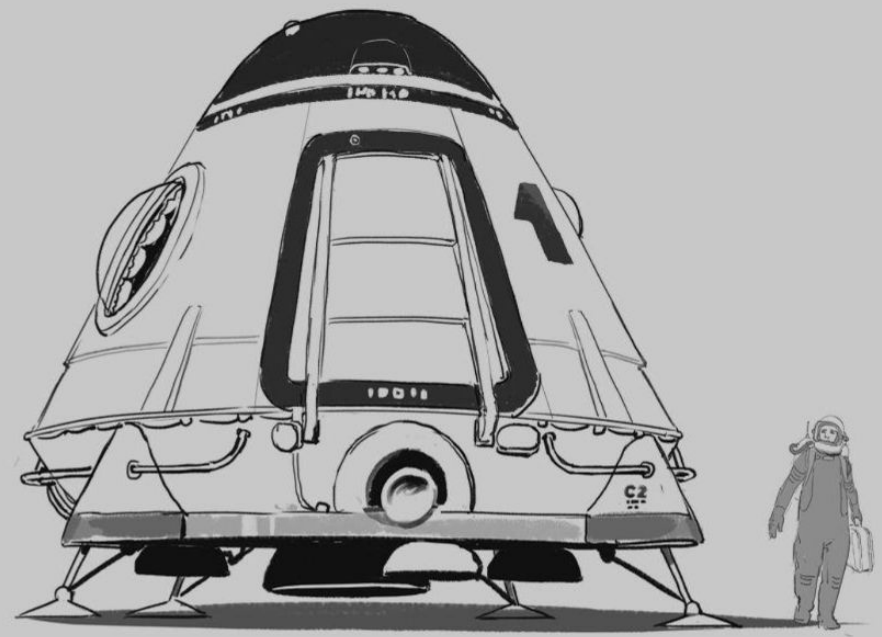
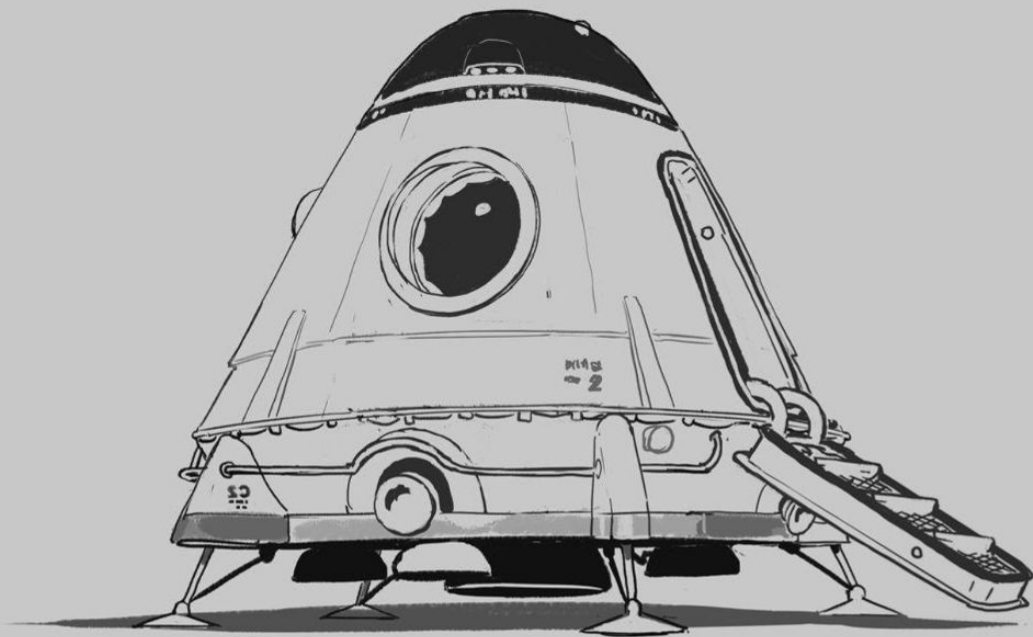


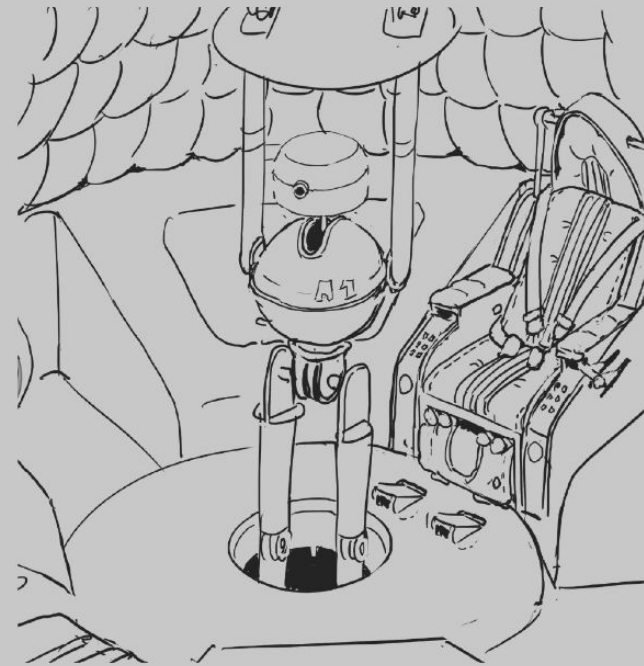
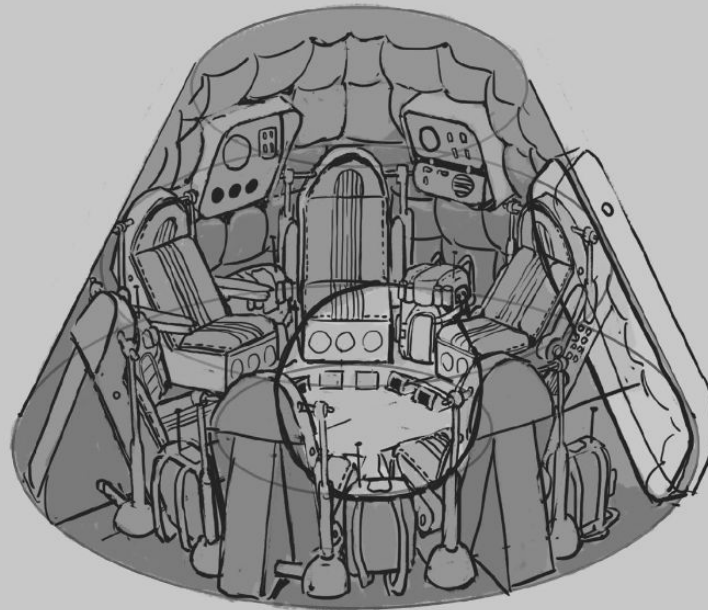
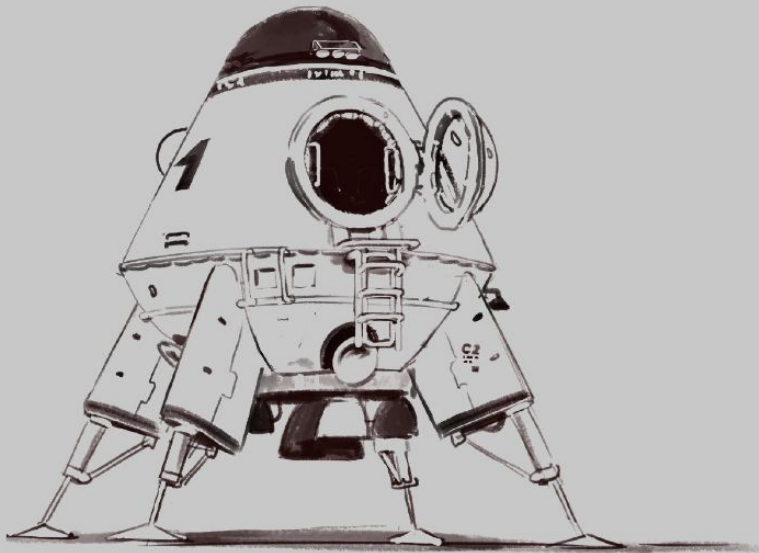


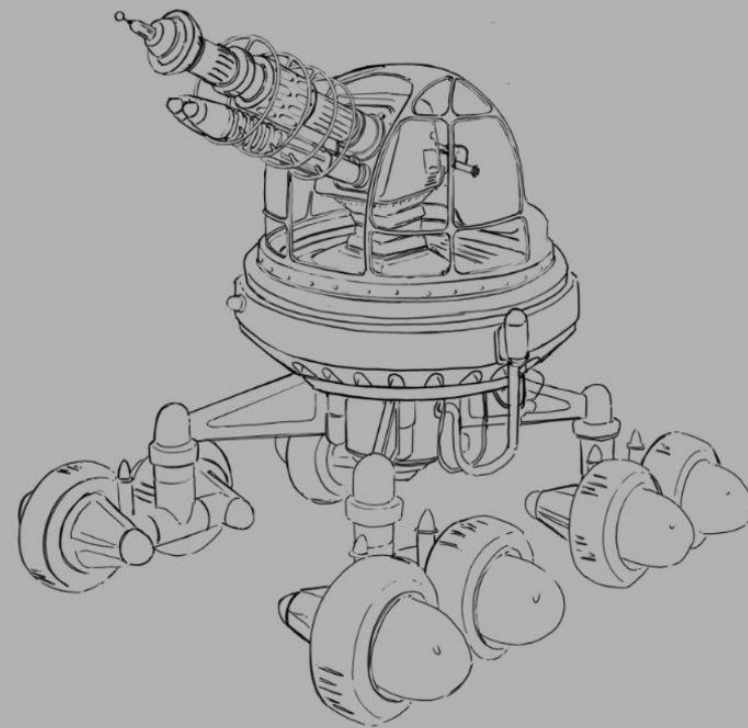
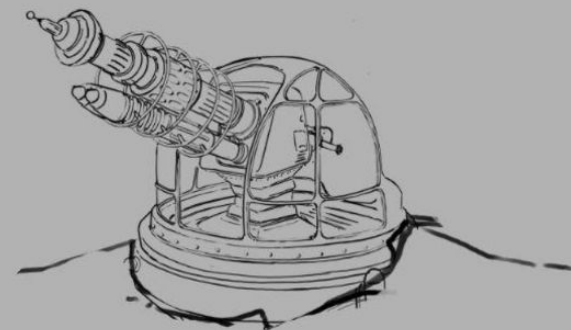
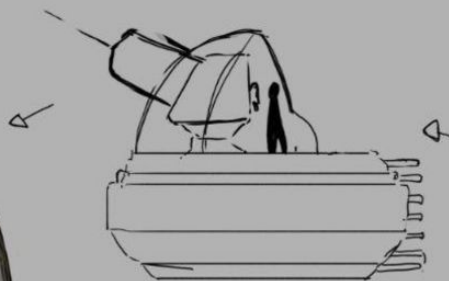
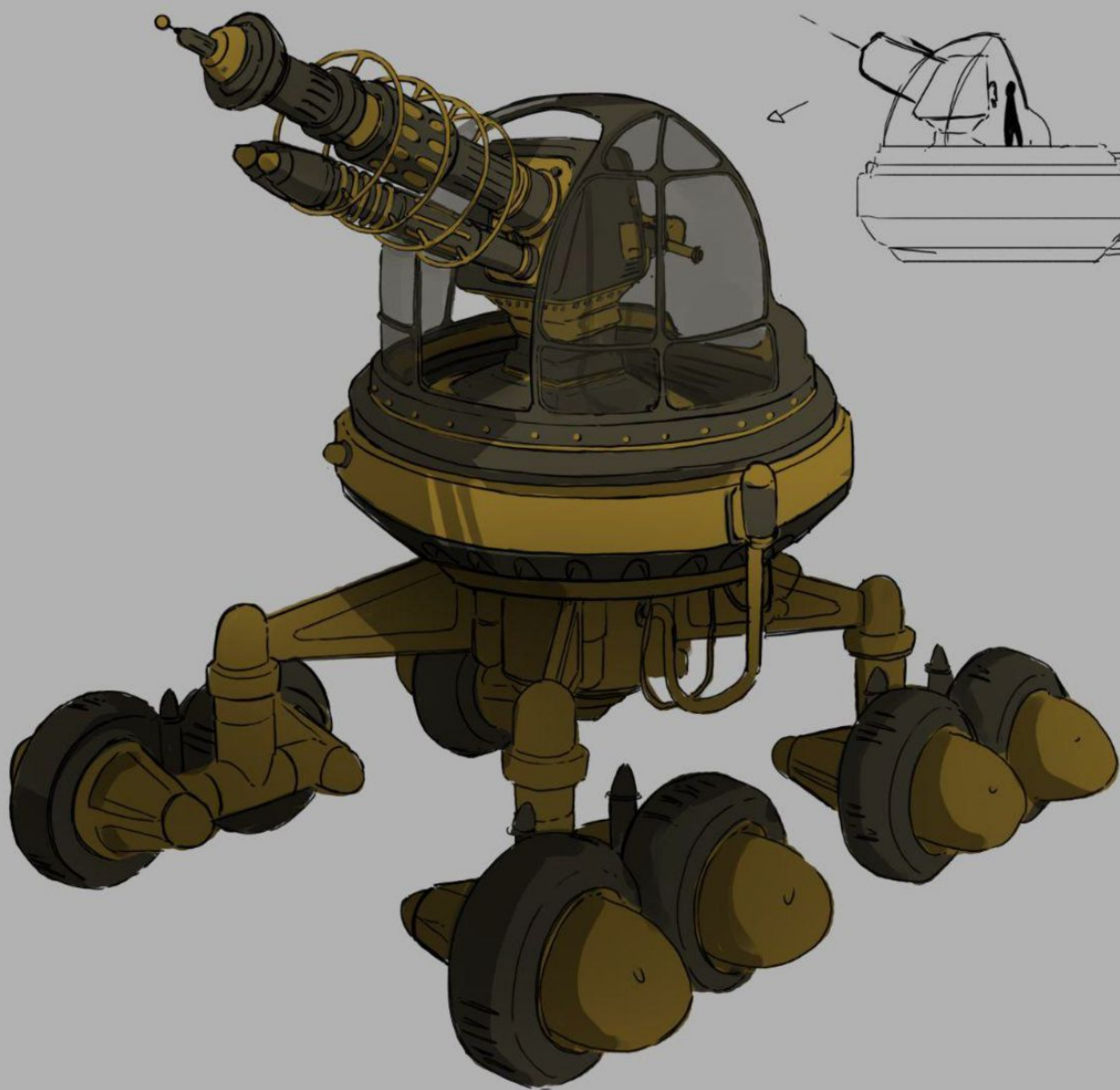


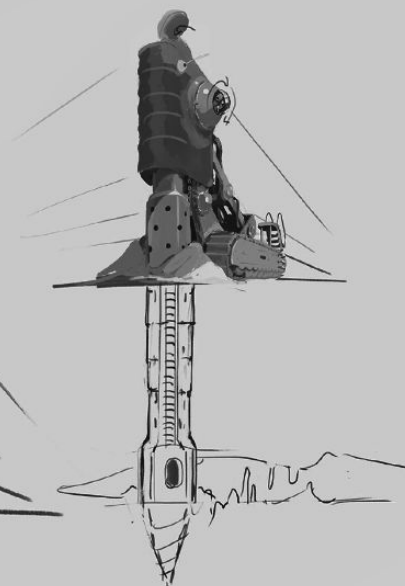
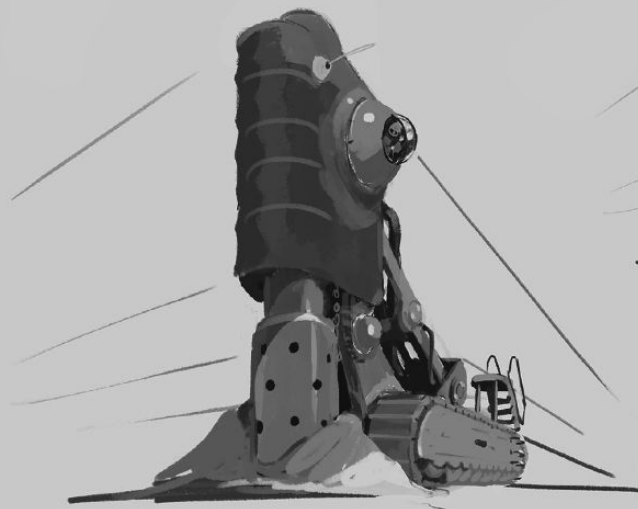
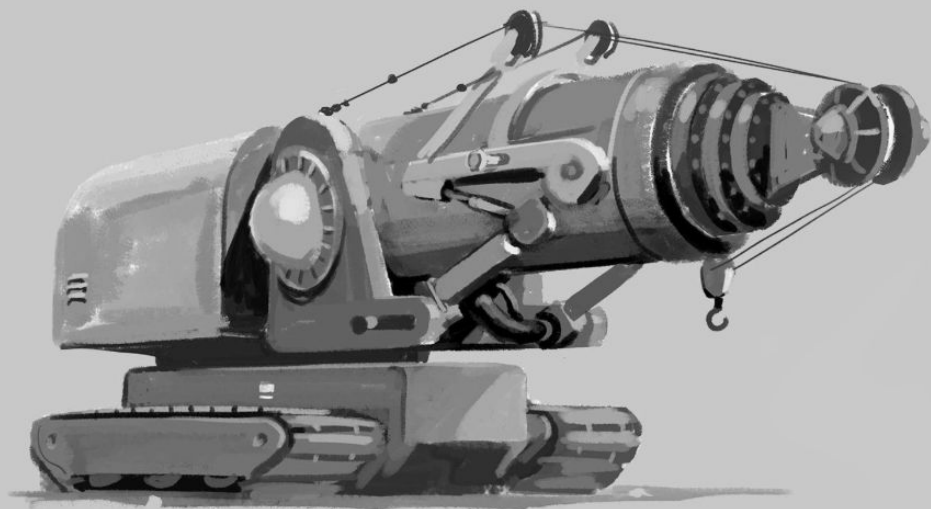
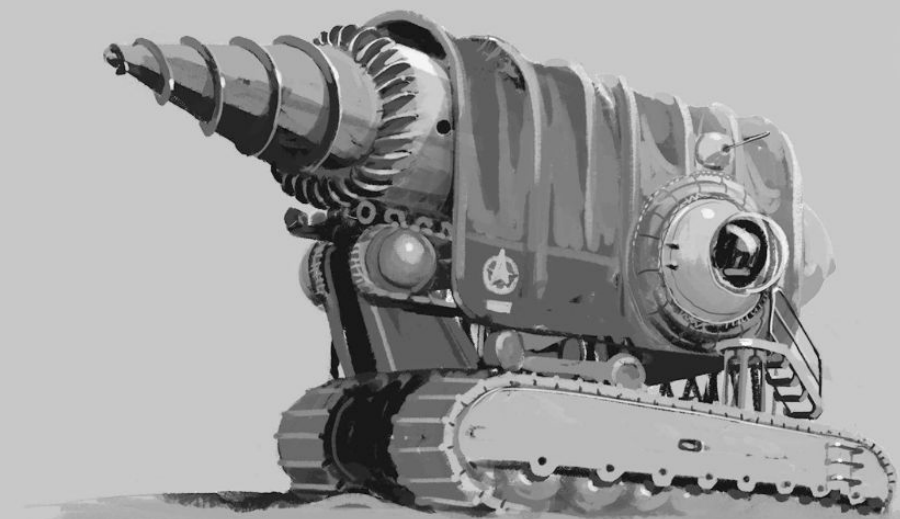


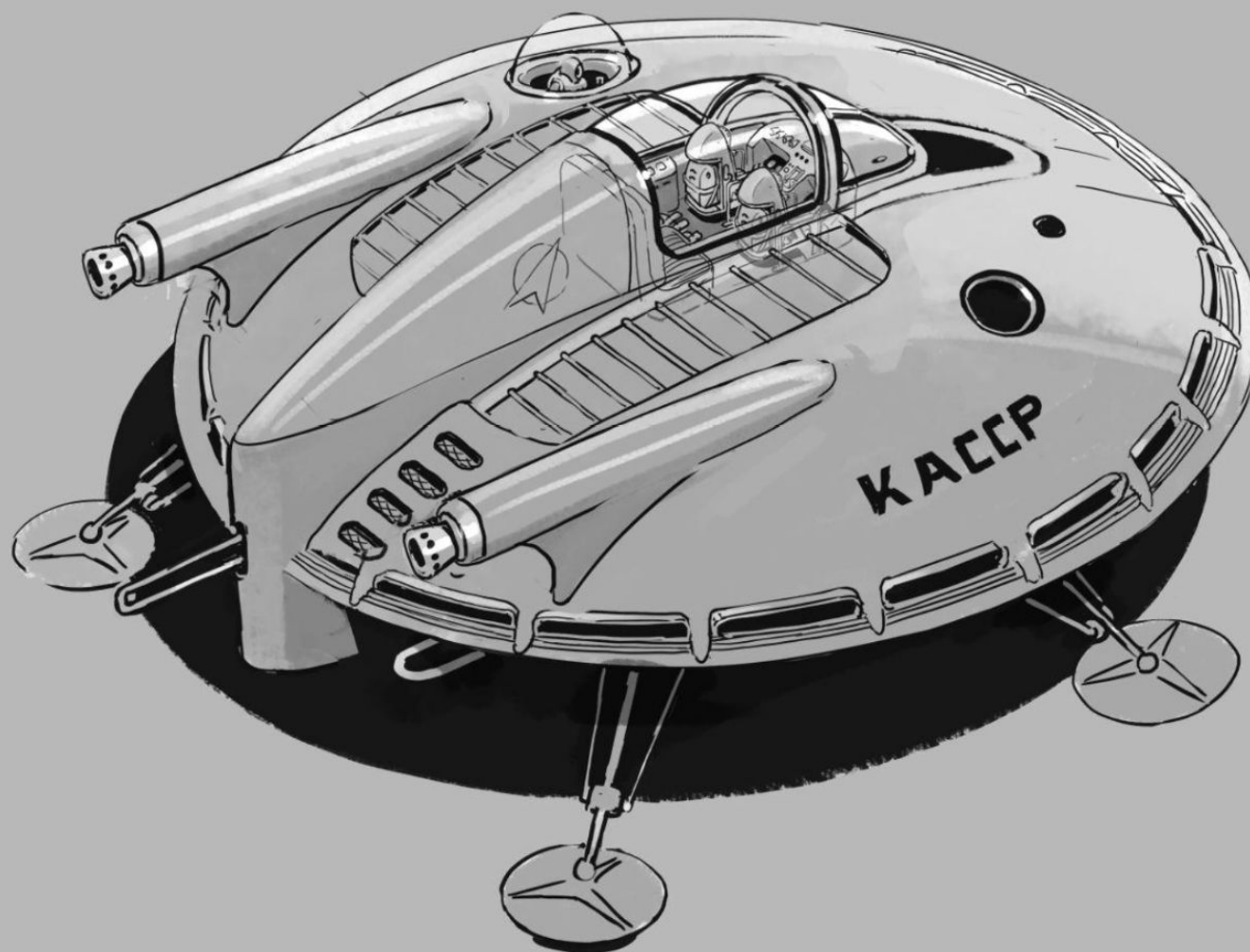




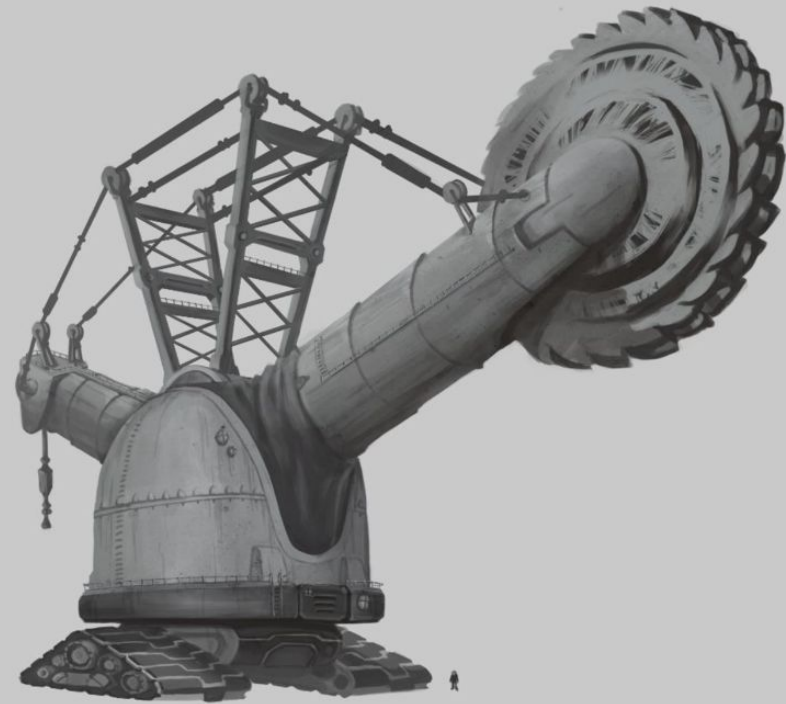
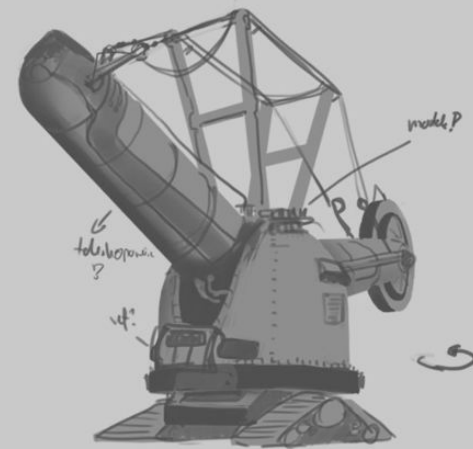
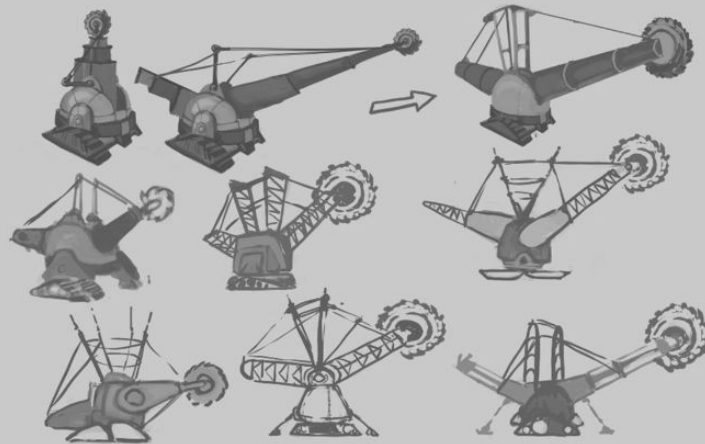


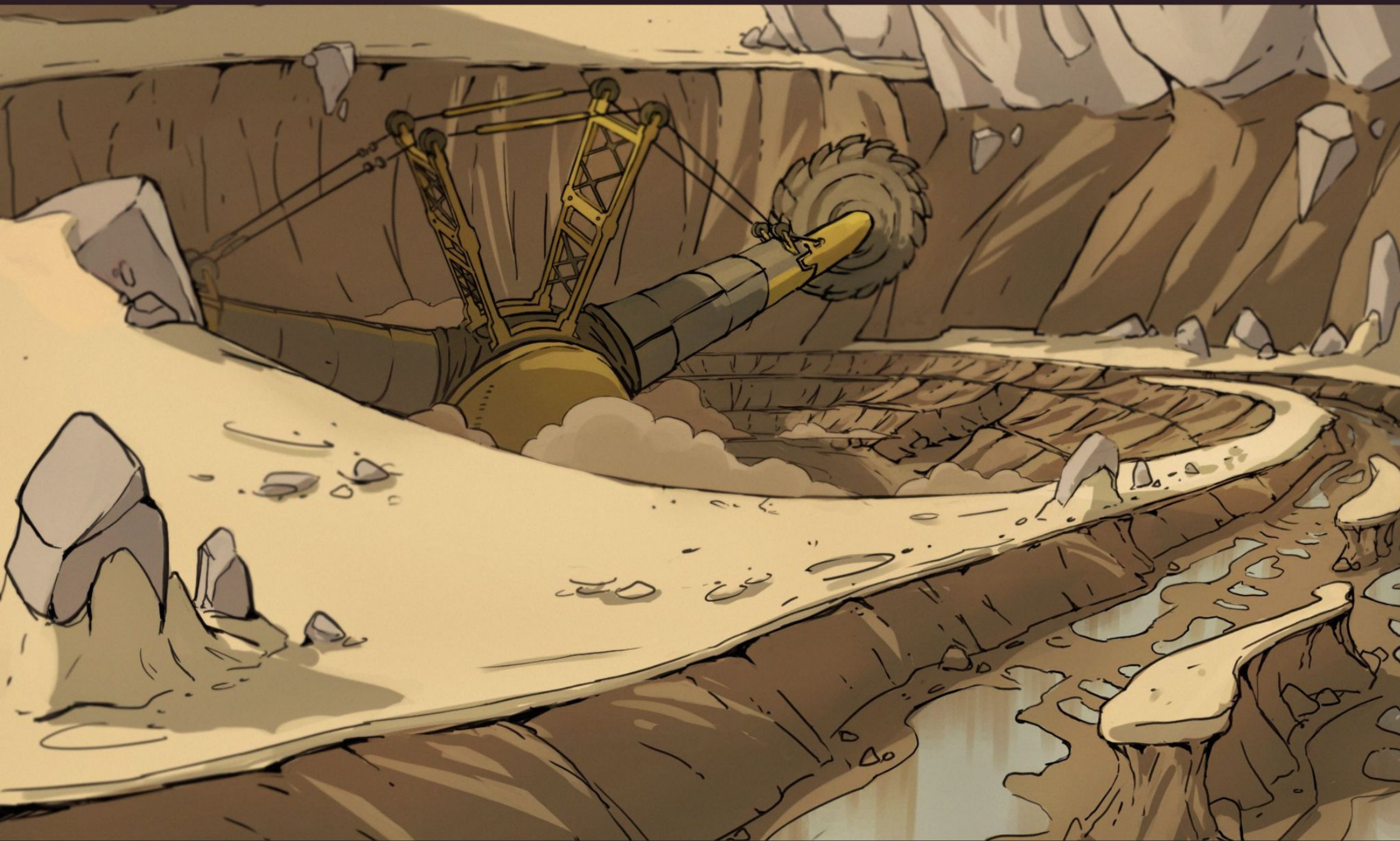




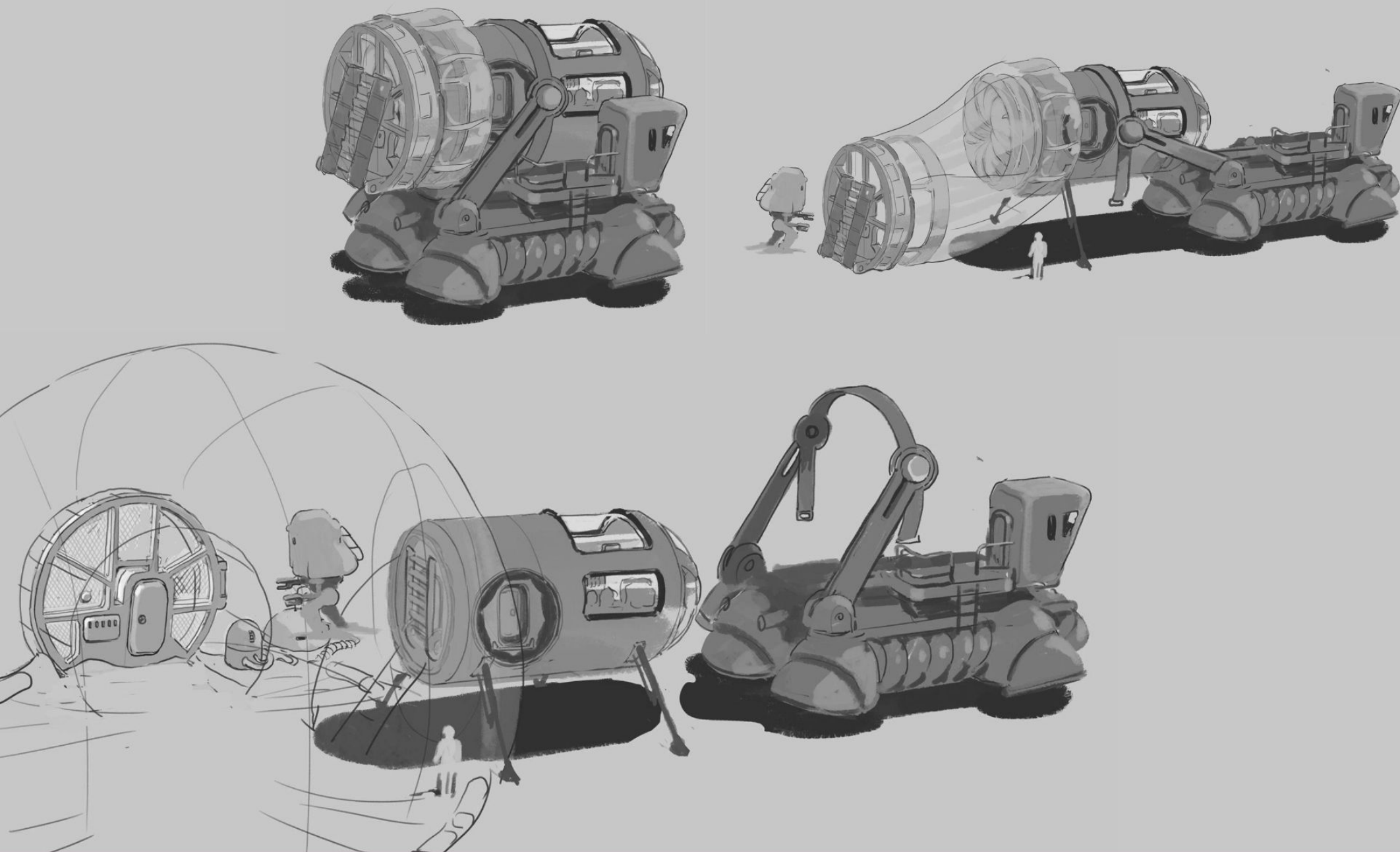


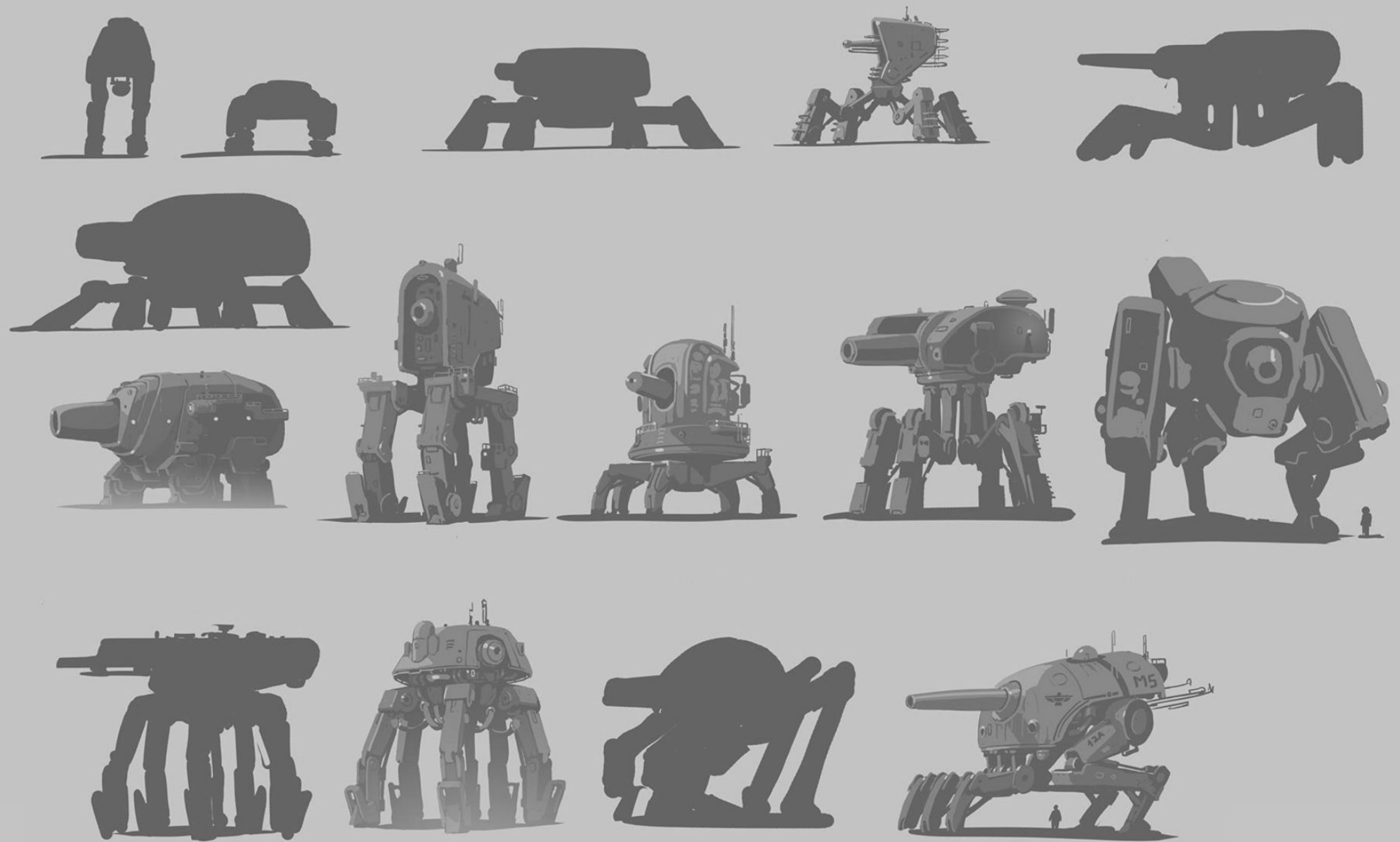


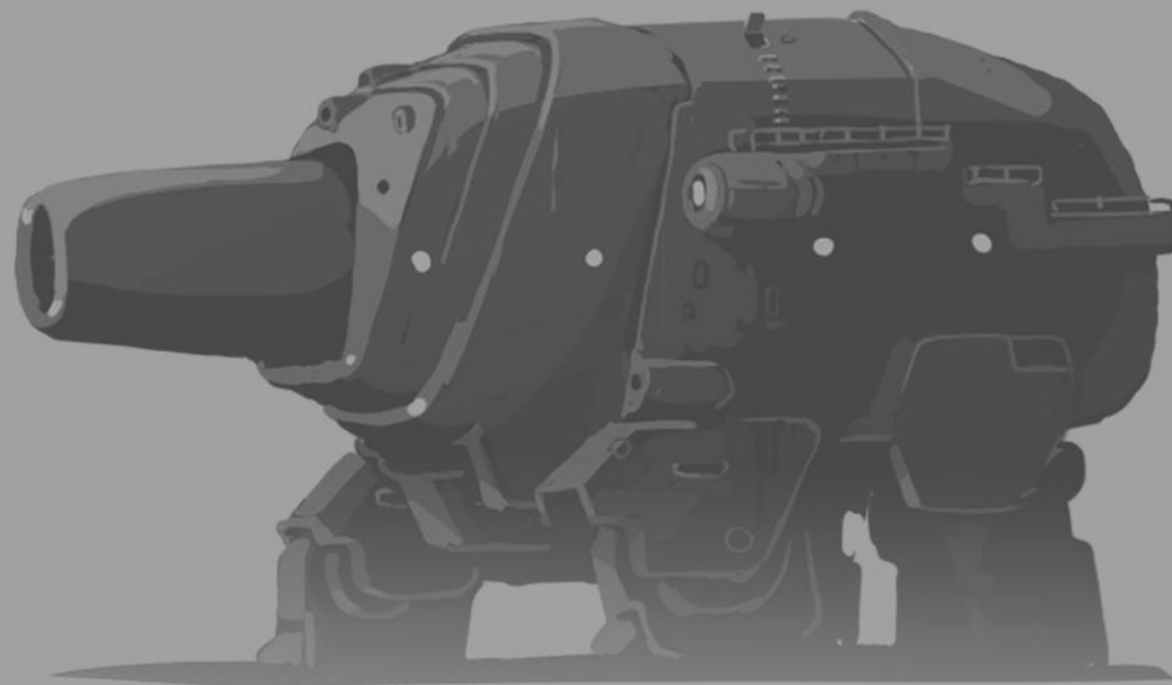


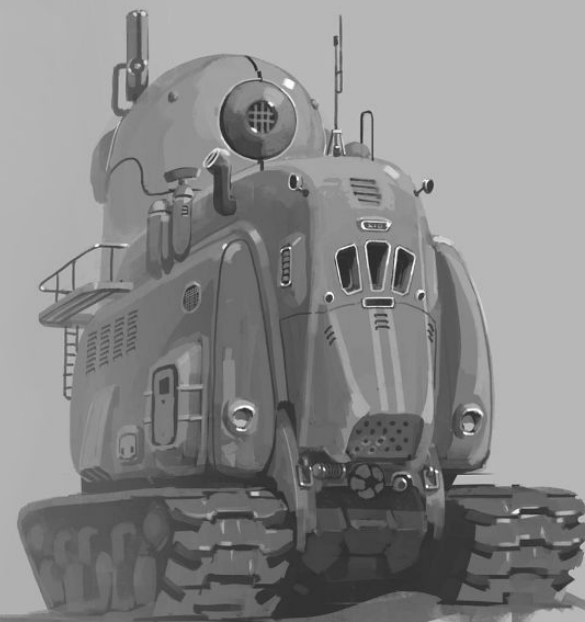
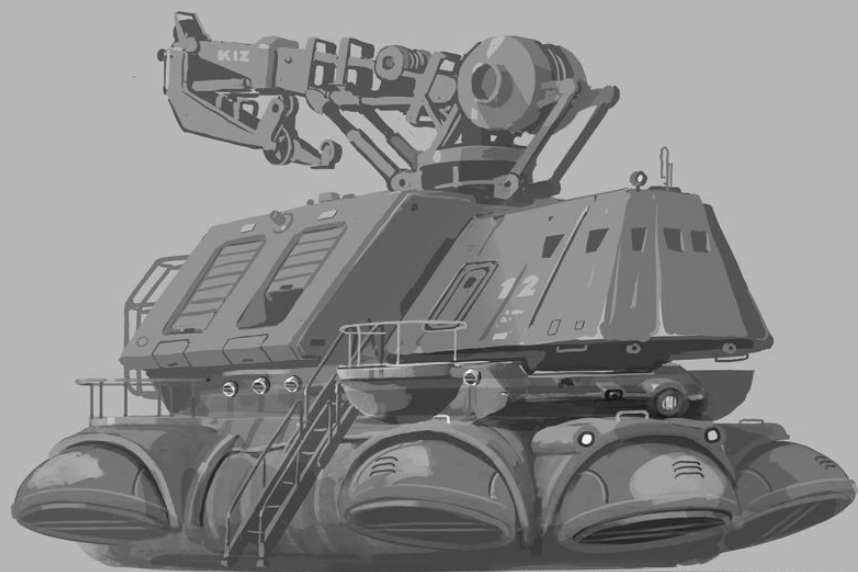


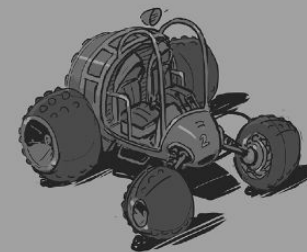
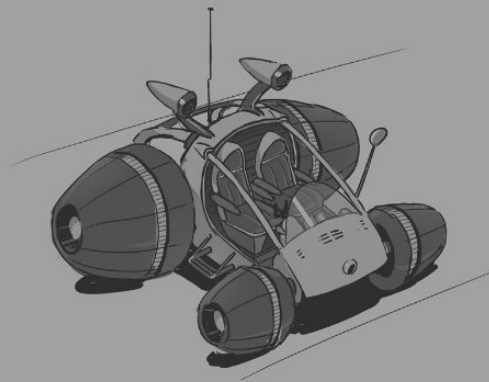
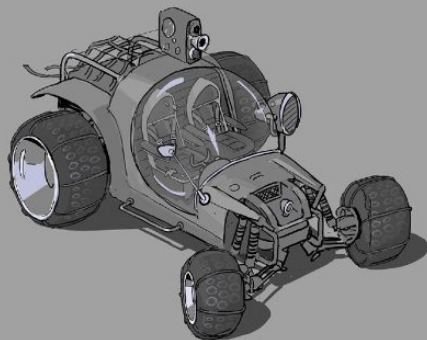
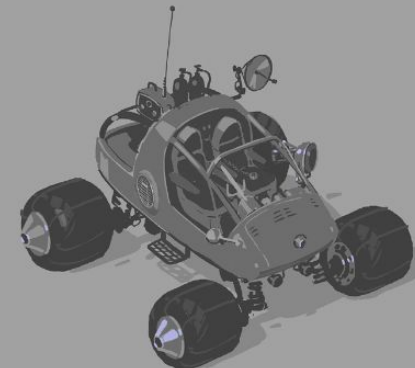
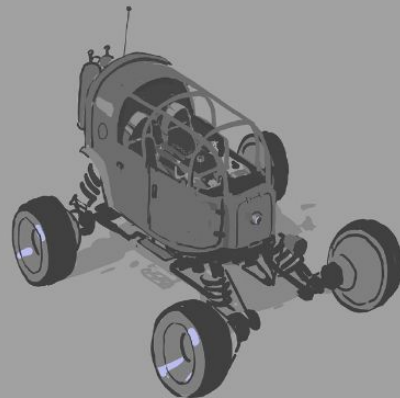
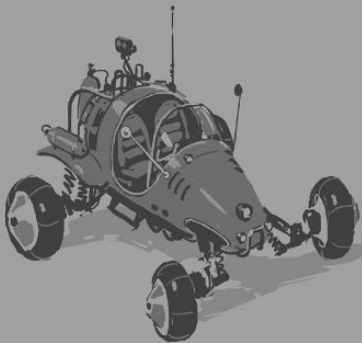
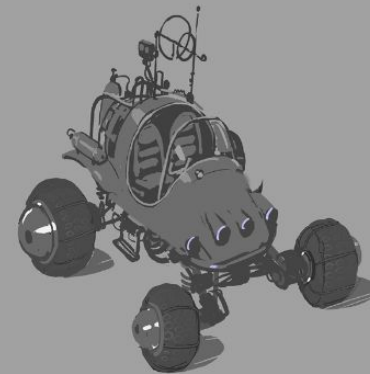
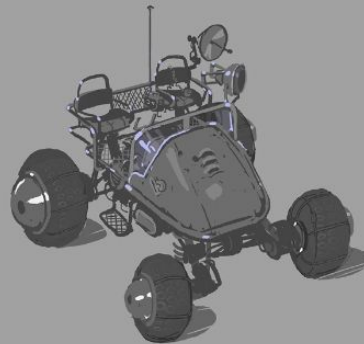
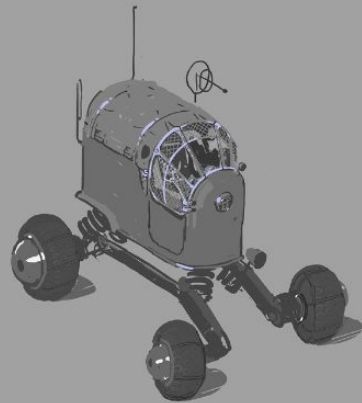


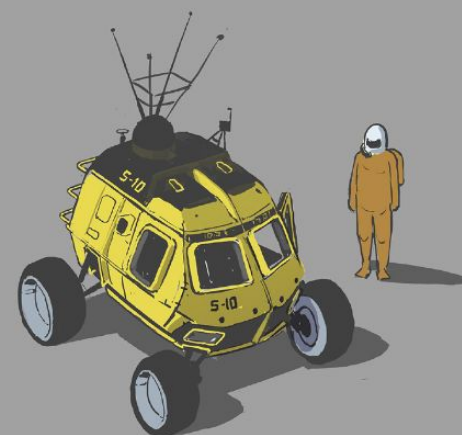
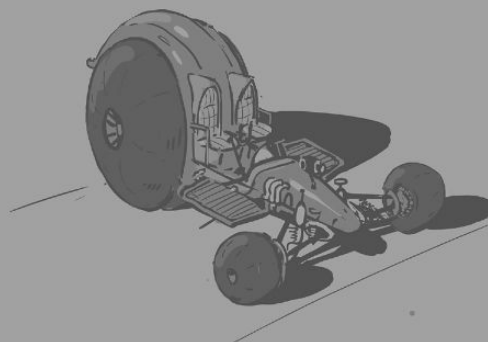
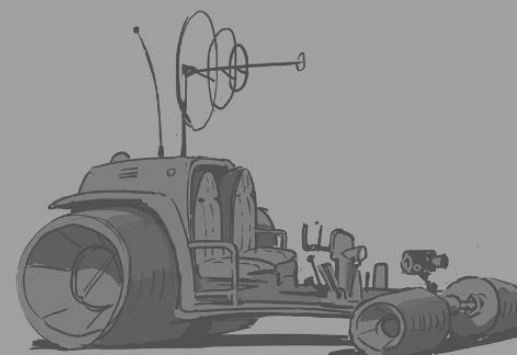
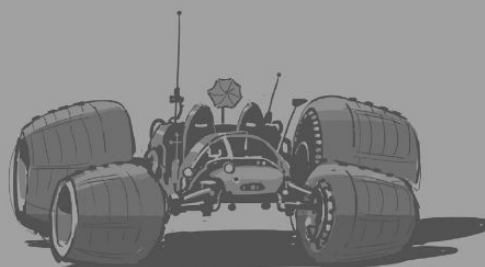
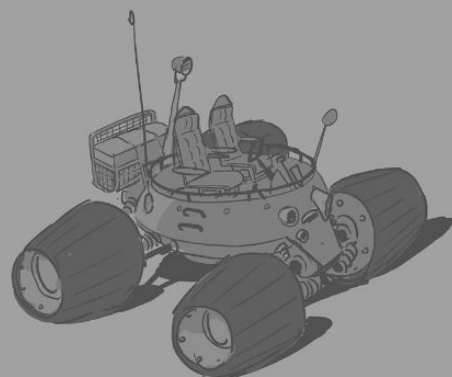
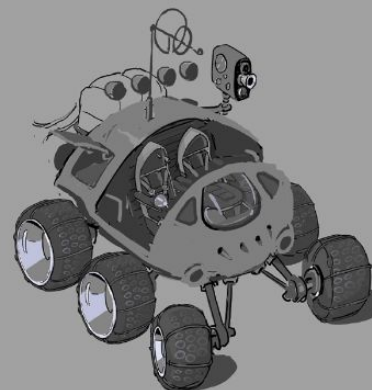
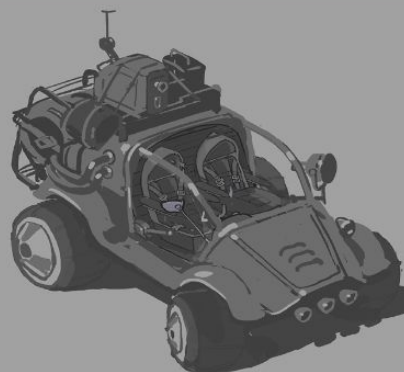
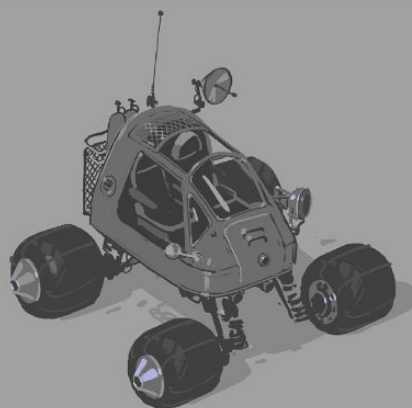




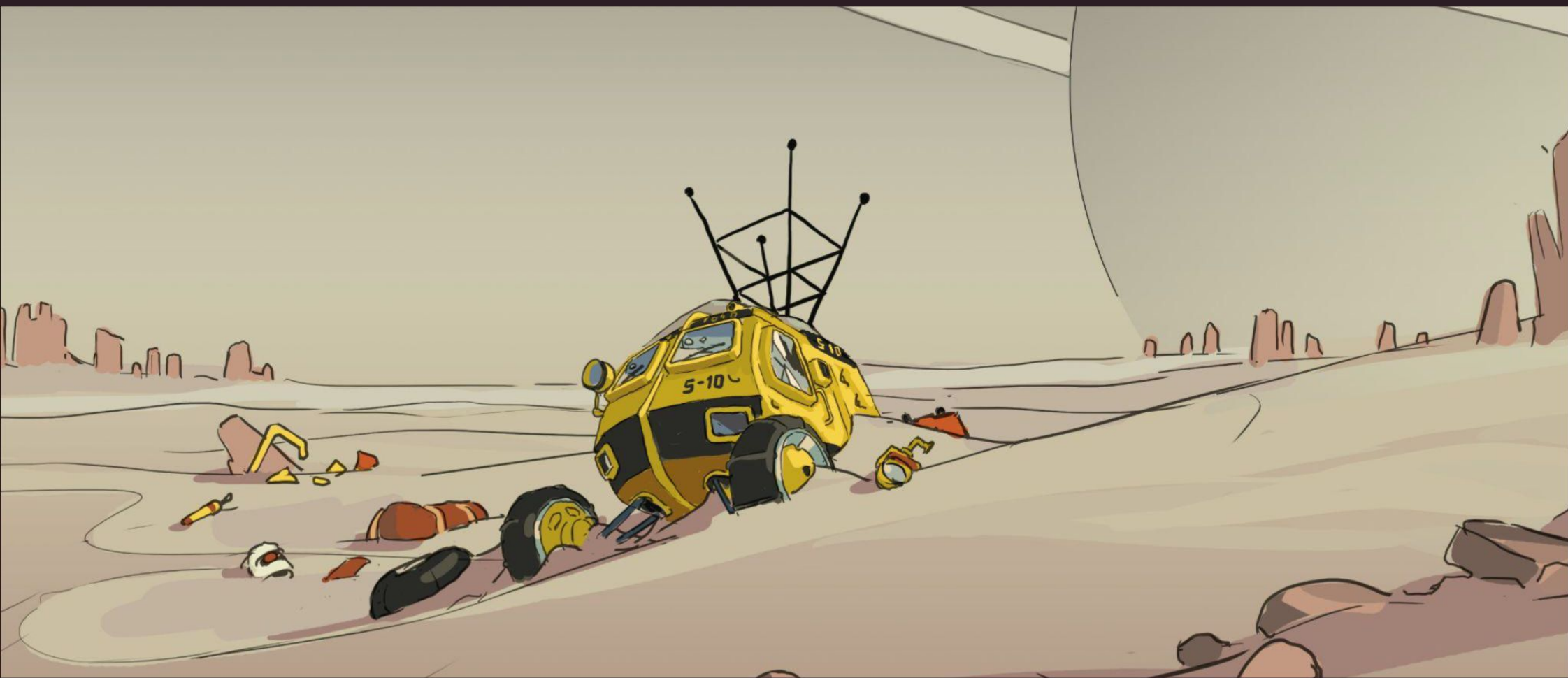


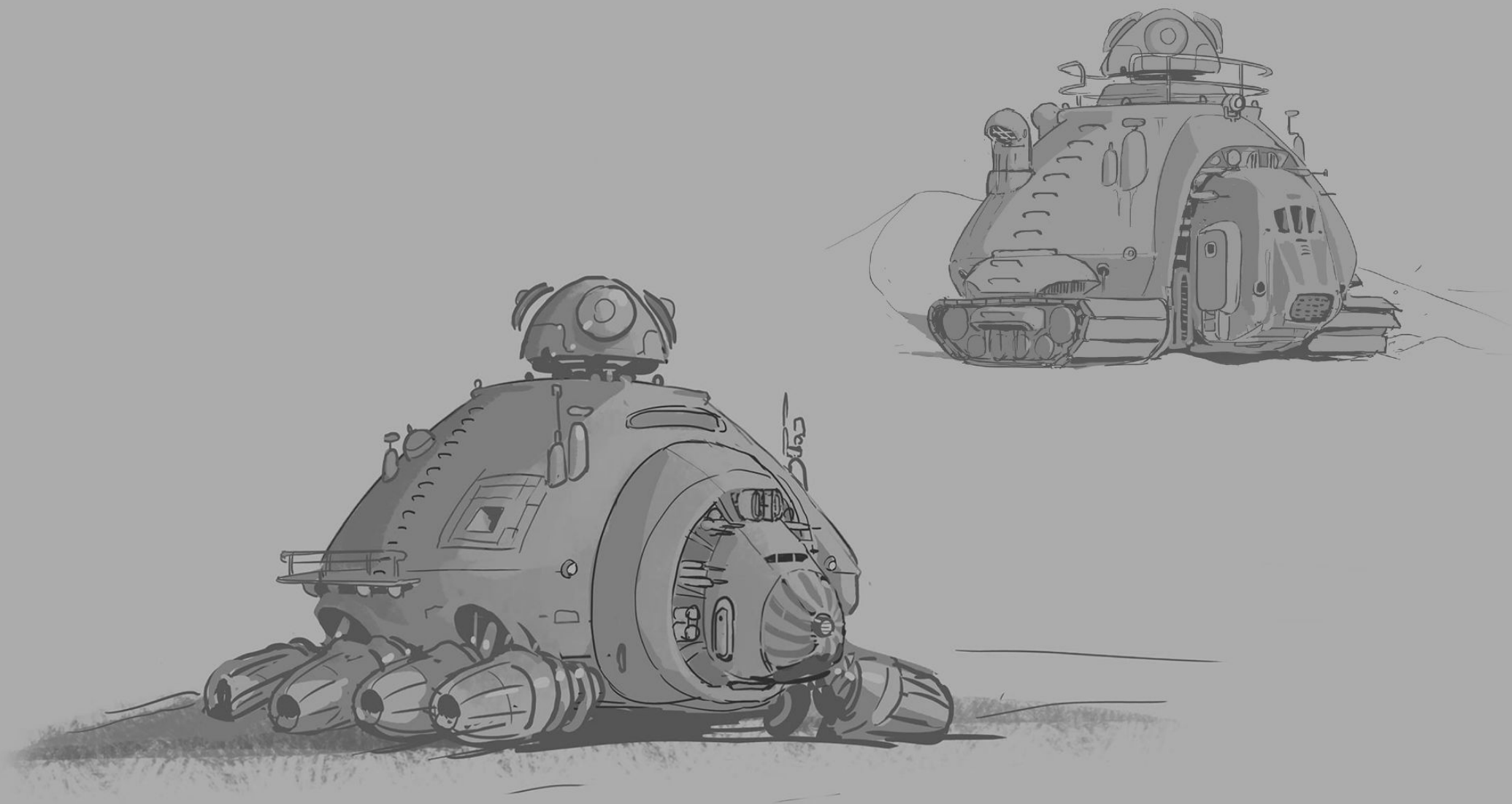








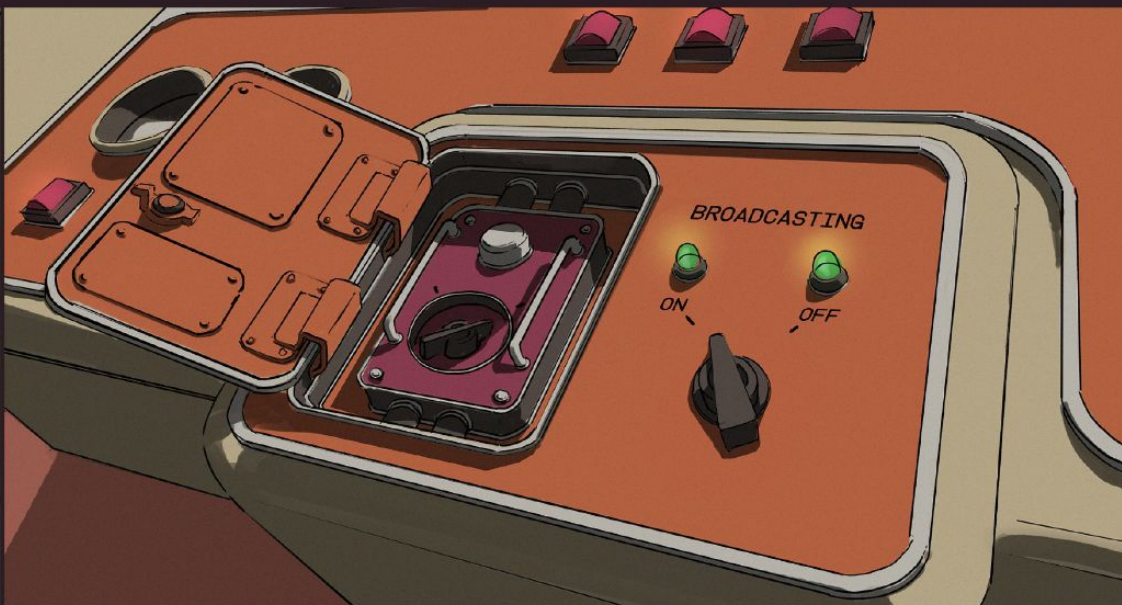




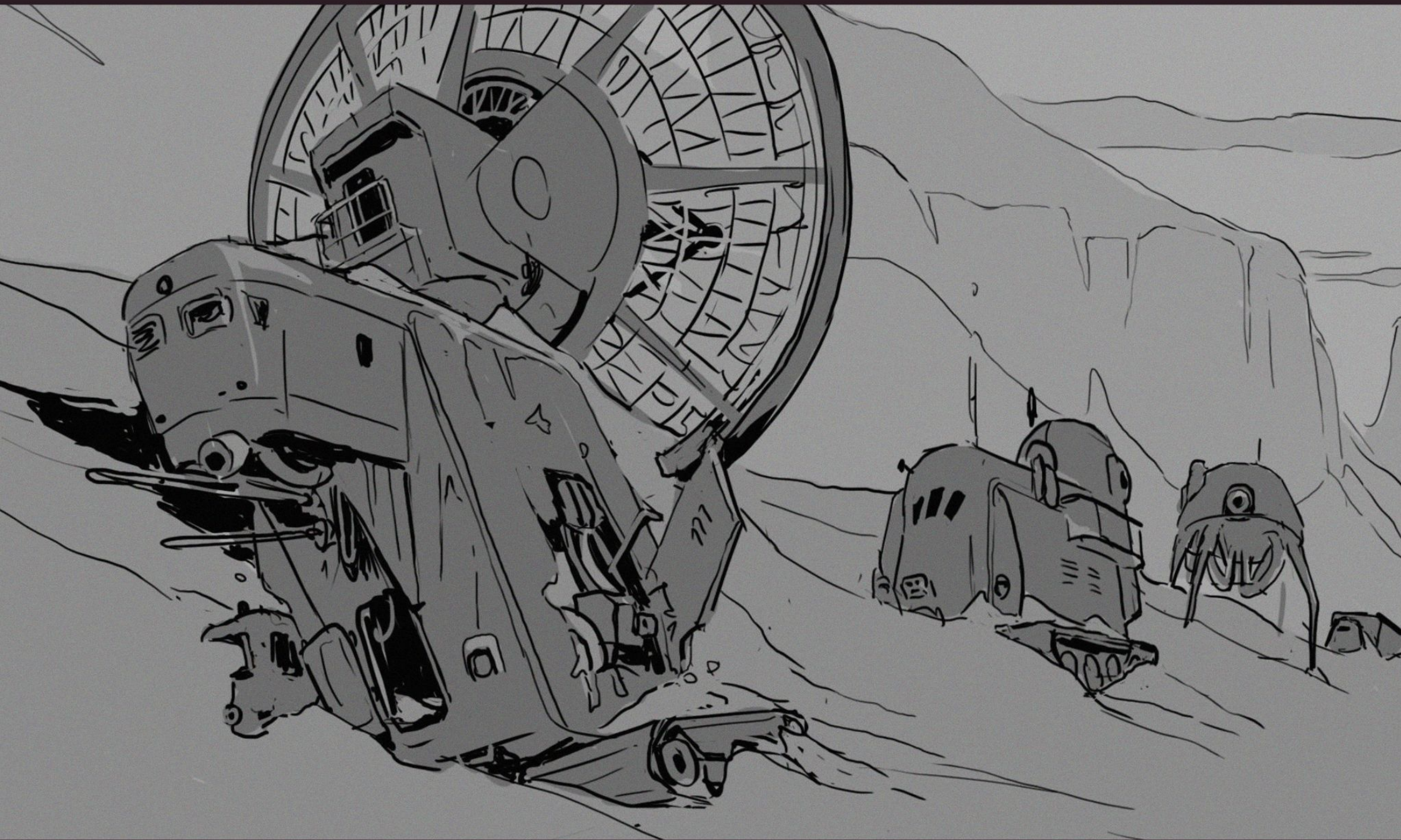


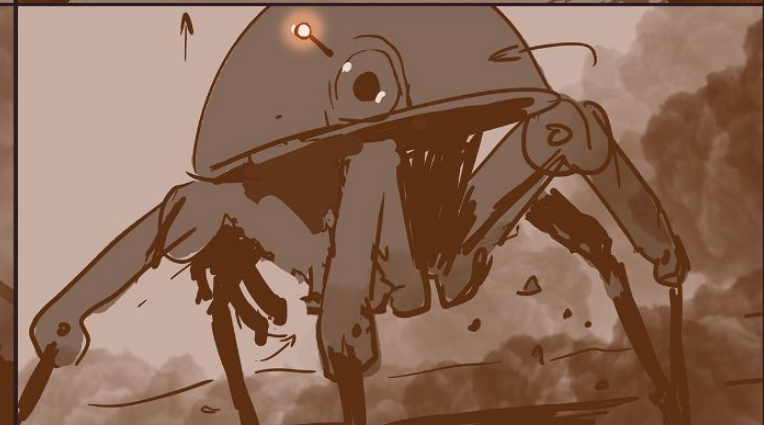
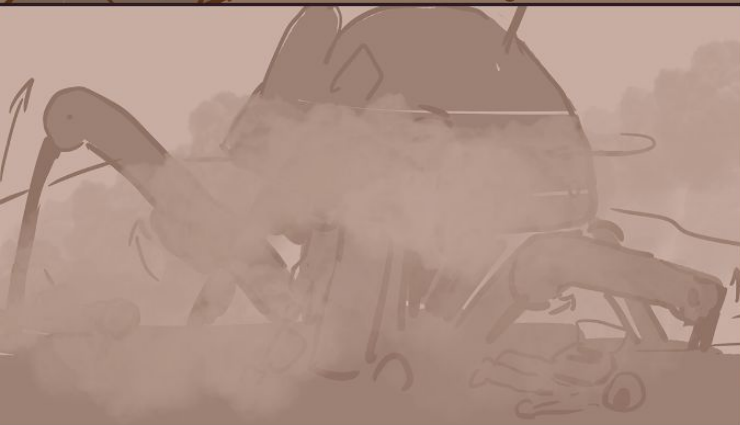
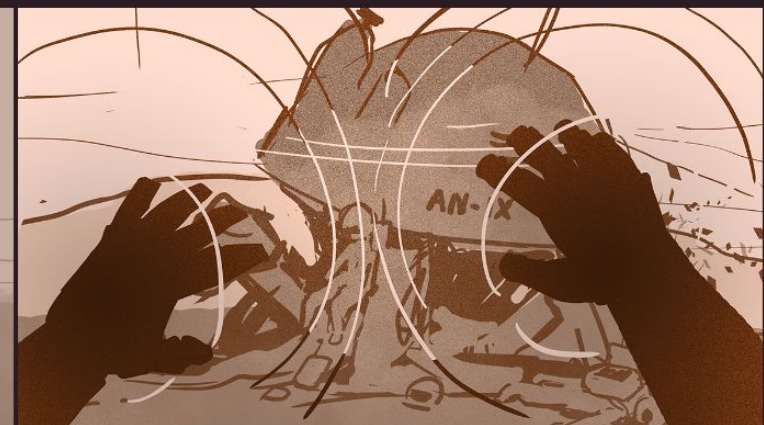


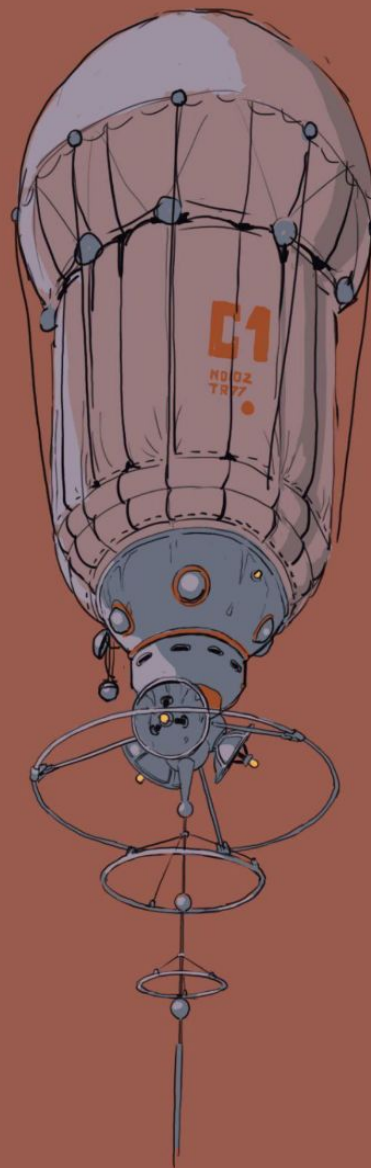


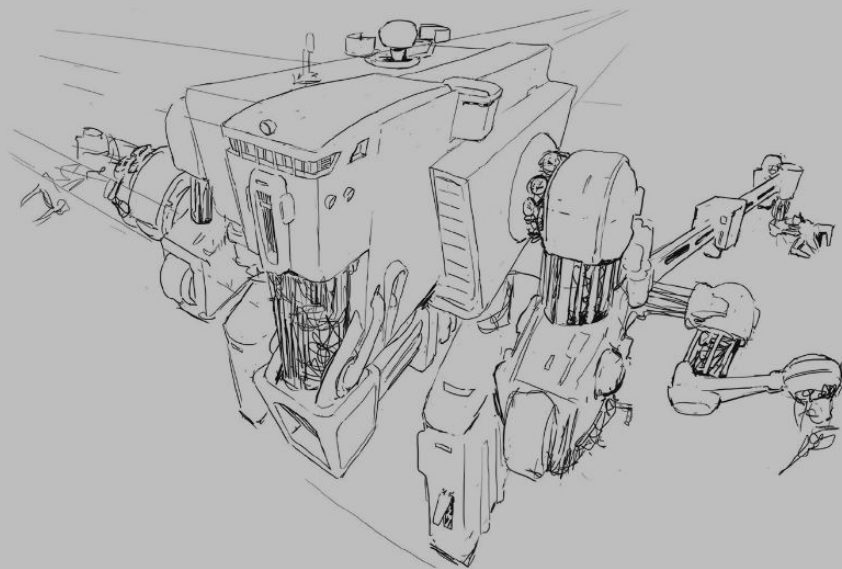
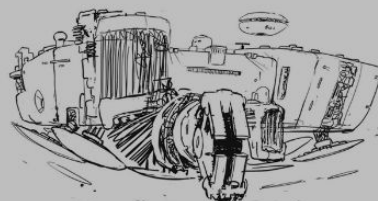
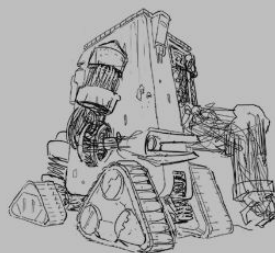
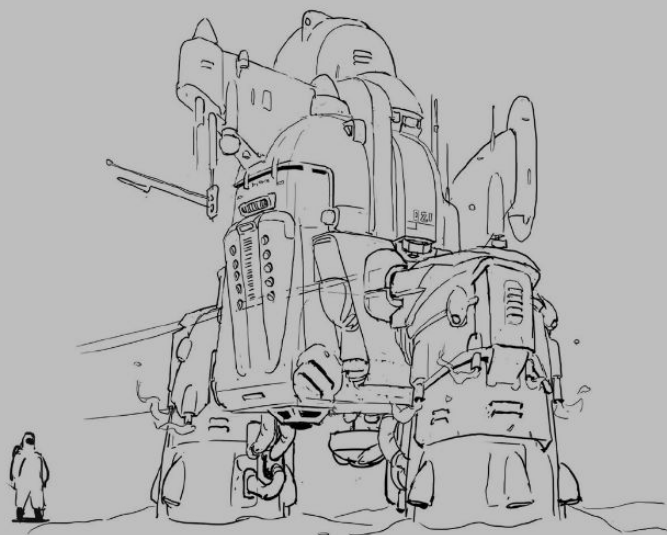


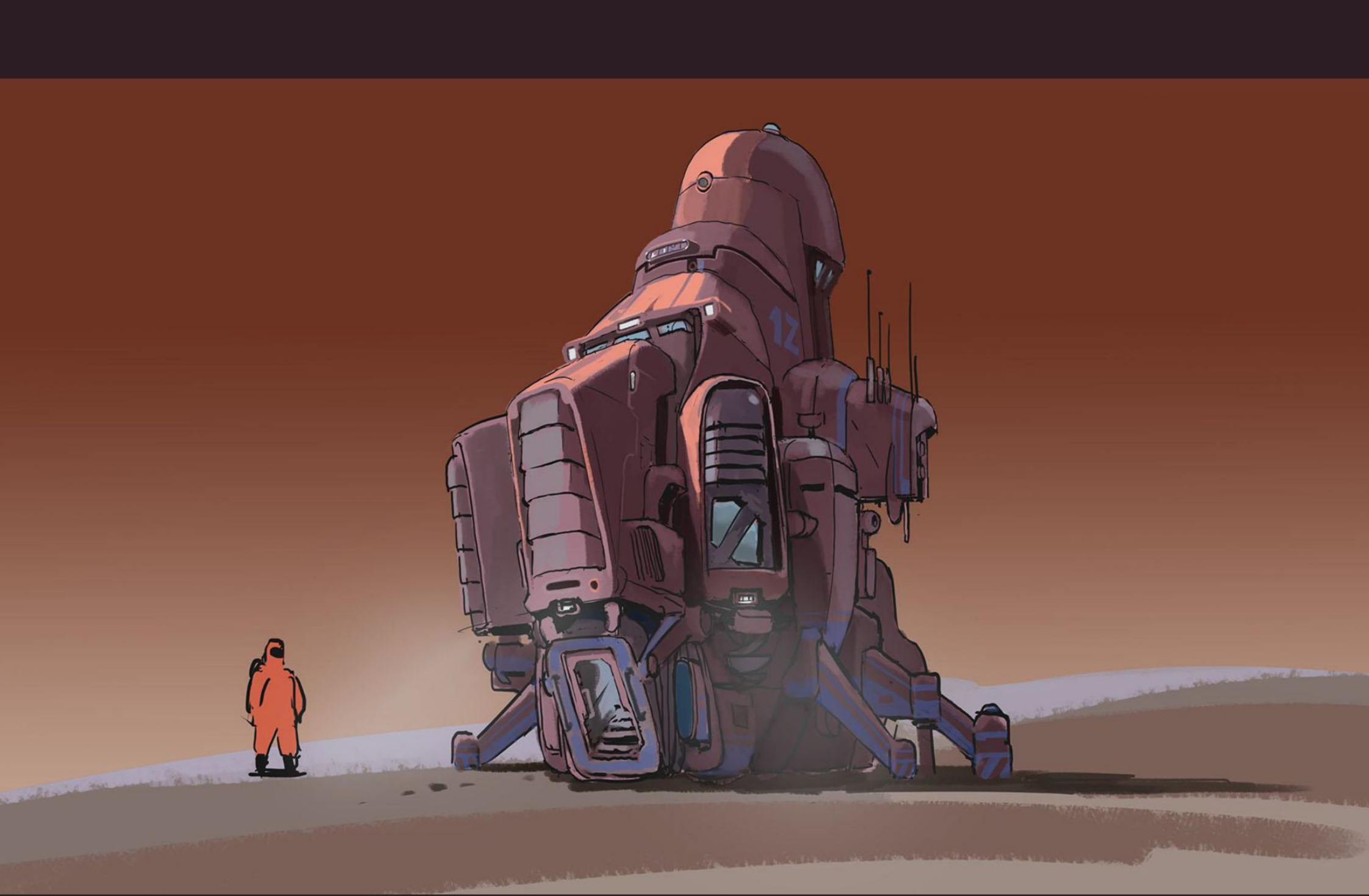


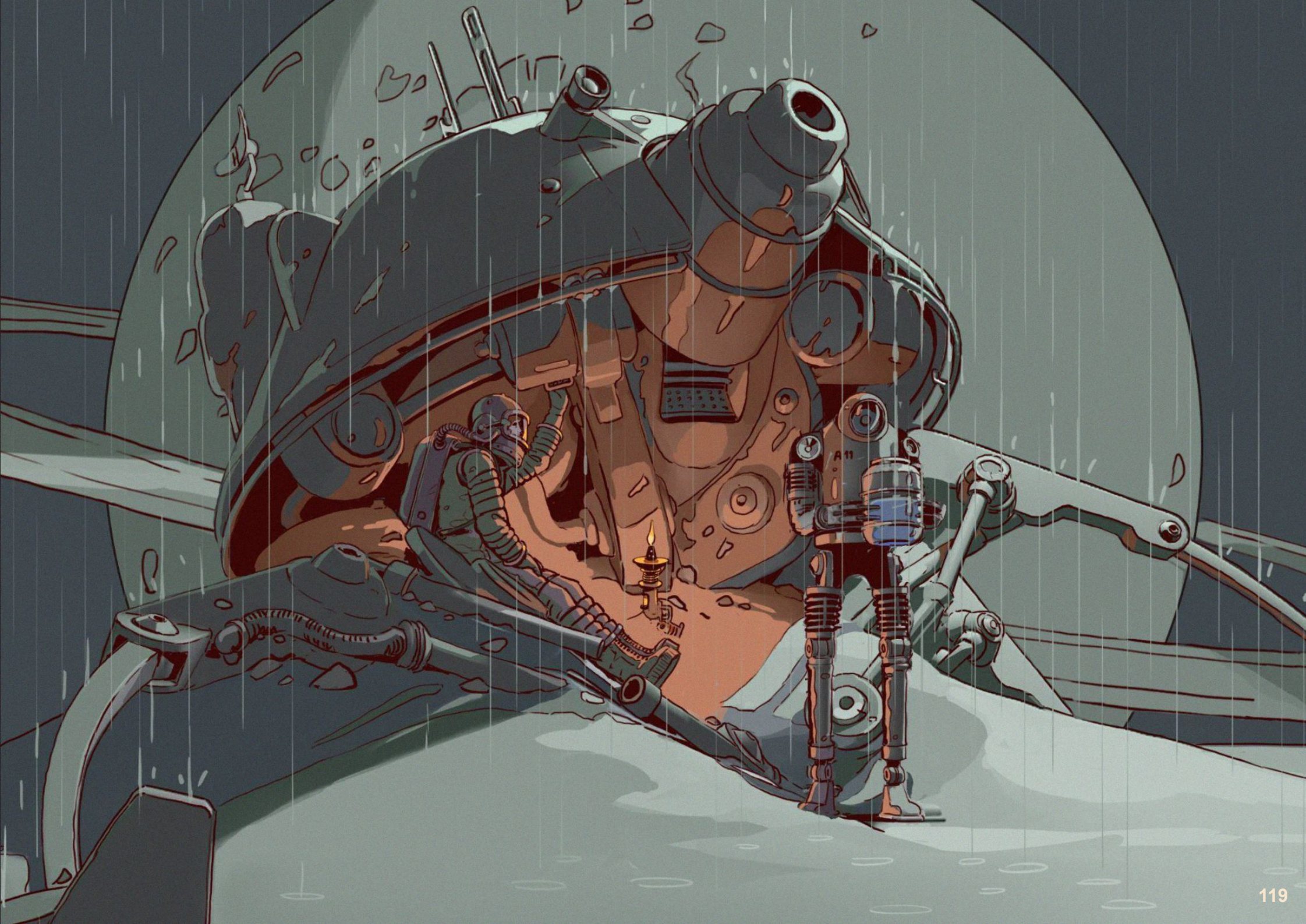














CONDOR

REGULATING SUIT PRESSURE, COOLING AND RECIRCULATING OXYGEN THROUGH THE PRESSURE GARMENT, AND WATER THROUGH A LIQUID COOLING AND VENTILATION GARMENT OR LIQUID COOLING GARMENT. TELEMETRY OF SUIT HEALTH PARAMETERS AND AN INDICATOR OF THE WEARER'S IMMEDIATE HEALTH.

OXYGEN TUBE

PROVIDING BREATHABLE OXYGEN, REMOVING CARBON DIOXIDE, HUMIDITY, ODORS, AND CONTAMINANTS FROM BREATHING OXYGEN.

NECK BEARING

ALLOWS THE HEAD TO MOVE FREELY.

PRESSURE RELIEF VALVE

MAIN ZIPPER

A SPECIAL AIRTIGHT ZIPPER.

CONVOLUTES

ACCORDION-LIKE FOLDS ALLOWED THE SUIT'S FLEXIBLE JOINTS TO MOVE WHEN PRESSURIZED. HAND CROPPED FROM LATEX, THE FOLDS CONTAINED NYLON TRICORD AND FLEXIBLE RESTRAINING RINGS TO RETAIN THEIR SHAPE WHEN INFLATED.

INTEGRATED BOOTS

BOOTS WERE CUSTOM MADE FOR EACH ASTRONAUT. SIZING A SUIT REQUIRED MEASURING THE ASTRONAUT ALONG MORE THAN 100 DIMENSIONS.

HELMET AND VISOR

HEAD PROTECTION, ANTI-SPATTER GLASS, TWO-WAY VOICE COMMUNICATION.

ANTI ABRASION PATH

WOVEN STAINLESS STEEL FABRIC OFFERED PROTECTION FROM THE LIFE SUPPORT BACKPACK.

SHOULDER BEARING

PREVENTED THE SHOULDERS FROM COLLAPSING UNDER THE WEIGHT OF THE BACKPACK.

SHOULDER JOINT

ELBOW JOINT

PROTECTION OF THE ELBOWS WITH A REINFORCED COMPOSITE MATERIAL, ALLOWS FREE MOVEMENT.

HUT

WRIST BEARING

ALLOWED THE HAND TO ROTATE FREELY.

GLOVE

THOSE ARE MADE OF FLEXIBLE RUBBER AND NEOPRENE TO PROVIDE ASTRONAUTS WITH THE MANUAL AGILITY NEEDED TO OPERATE TOOLS AND INTERACT.

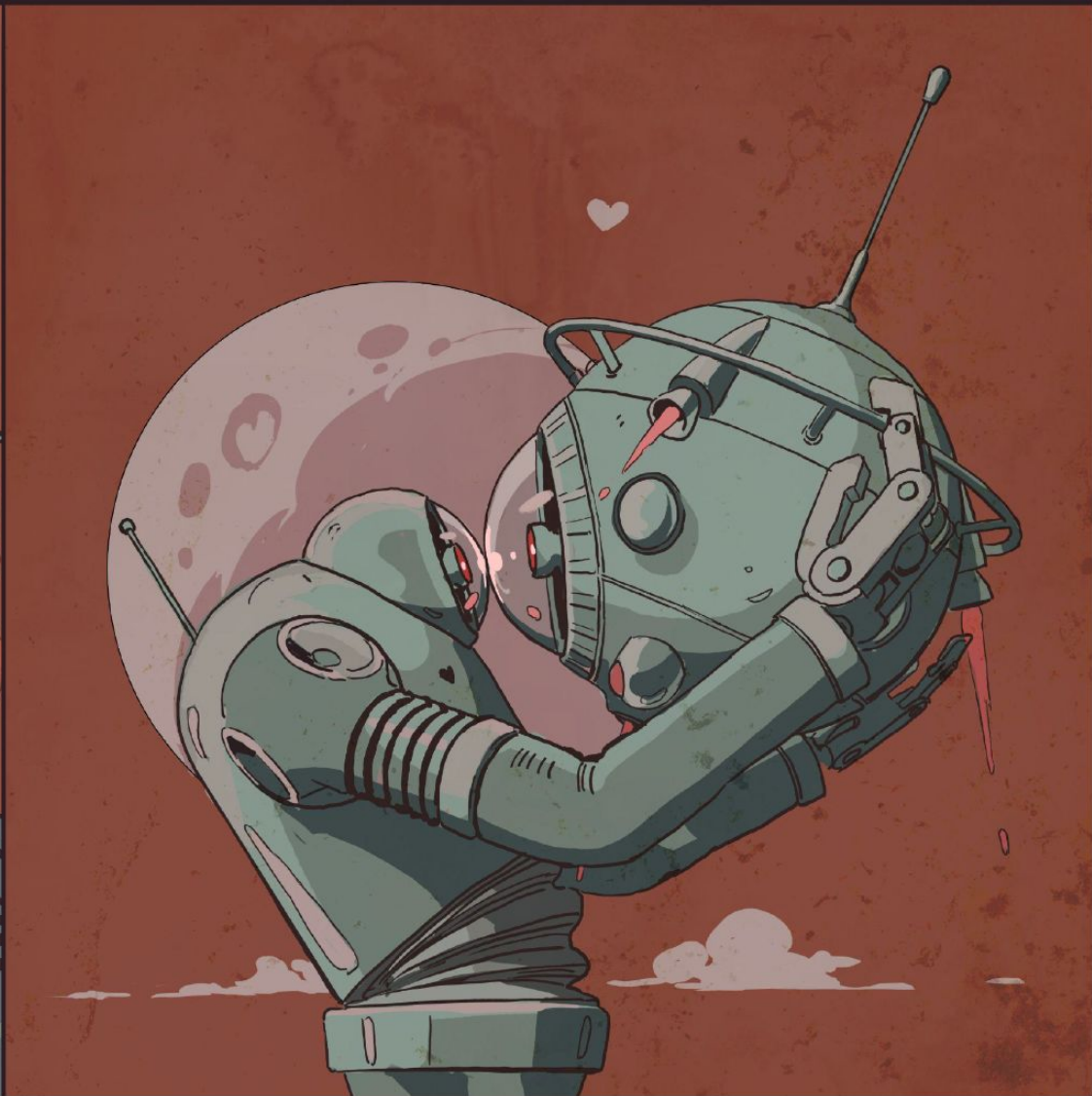

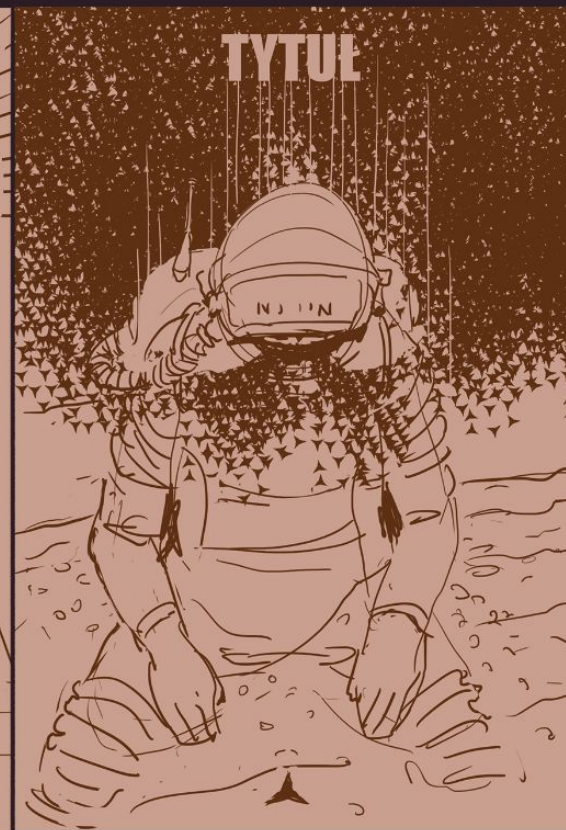
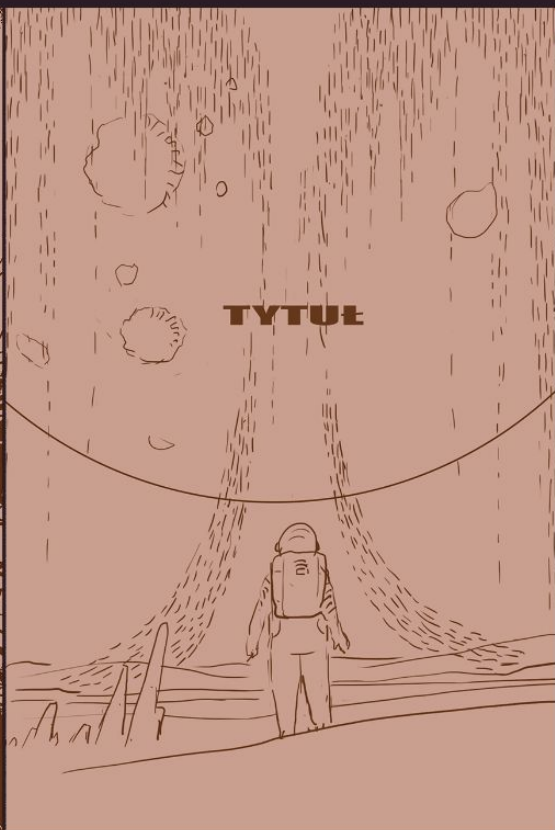
